- 4th meeting held – 07 July 2020

WORK PROGRESS

- *'Take-off Guidance (CART) Implementation Response Checklist' distributed to APAC States by ICAO APAC State Letter requesting submission of responses in implementation status and challenges/issues for Domestic Operations and International Operations separately.*
 - Responses were expected from States for, [Domestic Operations by 3 July](#), [International Operations by 10 July 2020](#).
 - State that have submitted the Checklist are: [8 States on domestic](#) and [6 States on International](#) as of [15 July 2020](#).
 - Checklist is a [one time survey](#) to capture State's challenges in implementing the CART's Take-off Document
 - identify areas that may require targeted assistance; and,
 - provide feedback for the on-going updates of the CART recommendations and guidance
 - ICAO APAC Regional Office was requested to extend the deadline of the State Letter for submission of responses.
- PH-SG agreed to use Stage '0' as default level for international operations as that is the current global pandemic situation



WORK PROGRESS

- Regarding the PH-SG Deliverable on appointing State Focal Points:
 - As recommended by the PH-SG to the ACCRPG 3rd Meeting, 26 June 2020, ICAO APAC Office issued the State Letter dated 7 July 2020 which requested States, amongst other matters addressed in the same State Letter, to [nominate focal points for the communication and coordination of the works of the APAC COVID-19 Contingency and Recovery Planning Group \(ACCRPG\) and its three sub-groups](#). States to respond most preferably by [17 July 2020](#).

- Regarding the PH-SG Deliverable on 'Assisting ACCRPG to improve awareness at State level of guidance in the [CART Take-off Guidance Document](#) through CAPSCA',
 - conducted the 13 CAPSCA – AP (Special) Meeting (virtual) on 16 July 2020. 27 APAC States, 12 industry and 5 International Associations, WHO HQ and WHO SEA Regional Office attended with a total of 135 participants (preliminary attendance data)
 - Meeting invited aviation and public health authorities of States to participate to promote multi-sectoral collaboration. However the attendance of public health authorities was poor.
 - Meetings was updated by ICAO and WHO on PH related developments. CAA Singapore briefed the meeting on UK-SIN CART Crew Module on-going Trials and PH-SG presented it's work on the Checklists.
 - Panel Discussion : Presentations centered on “Implementing PH Mitigation measures in Aviation” and ensuing Discussion also accommodated Q and A. Challenges/Issues/Ideas brought forward will be presented to the next PH-SG meeting for follow - up
