# ICAO ACCRPG Safety Sub-Group

Progress Report at ACCRPG/4

July 17, 2020



- Four meetings conducted through July 15
- Supported by 11 States/SARs and 6 Int'l Organizations/Industry
- Focus remains:
  - Recommendation 1: During the global COVID-19 outbreak, Member States should continue updating COVID-19 Contingency Related Differences (CCRDs) in the Electronic Filing of Differences (EFOD) subsystem;
  - Recommendation 2: Member States should avoid retaining any COVID-19 related alleviation measures as soon as normal operations are resumed. Differences that remain after the contingency if any should be filed in the EFOD system; and
  - Recommendation 3: Member States should expedite the development of guidance for safety management of new operations or operation change during this crisis.



- Recommendation #1:
  - CCRD APAC submission is 83% as of July 15
- Recommendation #2
  - Alleviations issued to facilitate ongoing aviation activities -- some are or about to expire
  - ICAO and IATA have made CCRD information available, including an online dashboard, ICAO proactively contacting states
- Recommendation #3:
  - Guidance – JCAB and CASA ramp inspections
  - Guidance – IATA Flight and Cabin Operations, including for face masks
  - IATA operational notice issued on Unstable Approaches, observed in flight data
