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Aviation Security and Facilitation-related measures (AVSEC/FAL) sub-group

The 7th AVSEC/FAL subgroup meeting was held on the 19th August 2020 and addressed the following:

- Discussion on Passenger Health Declaration Forms for CART Recommendation 7 - harmonization of the forms and the information to be gathered
- Update on Guidelines for Aviation Security Contingency Measures During the COVID-19 Pandemic and Webinar/ IPACK – 2 webinars completed and disseminated documents on COVID security guidance for airports, developed by ACI



- Identification of major challenges/obstacles facing AVSEC/FAL re-start and recovery operations: 5 States and 2 industry partners provided inputs on challenges faced, for e.g.
 1. Integration/appropriate public health risk management for security screening points
 2. Training/maintain security screening staff competency during prolonged periods of no activity
 3. Oversight activities during COVID-19 pandemic – AVSEC vs Covid Safe Management Measures
 4. Lack of harmonization on pre-departure testing requirements
 5. No consensus on facilitating recovered COVID-19 patients to travel
