# Aviation Safety-related Measures

- **Recommendation 1:** During the global COVID-19 outbreak, Member States should continue updating COVID-19 Contingency Related Differences (CCRDs) in the Electronic Filing of Differences (EFOD) subsystem >>> 85%
- **Recommendation 2:** Member States should avoid retaining any COVID-19 related alleviation measures as soon as normal operations are resumed. Differences that remain after the contingency if any should be filed in the EFOD system >>> *Monitoring with on-going discussion.*
- **Recommendation 3:** Member States should expedite the development of guidance for safety management of new operations or operation change during this crisis >>> *On going, eg. Review, update and amend GMs according to current QRGs.*



## ACCRPG/8 Update

- Additional safety-related CART Rec #12

- Recommendation 12

States should put in place the necessary measures to mitigate risks associated with prolonged regulatory alleviations and should not extend alleviations (both core and extended COVID-19 Contingency Related Differences (CCRDs)) beyond 31 March 2021, unless circumstances dictate otherwise. In addition, States are encouraged to facilitate access to medical and training facilities, including flight simulation training devices used for flight crew (national and foreign) to maintain their certificates, recency of experience and proficiency.



## ACCRPG/8 Update

- Discussion transportation of vaccine by air with relevant agencies started and consideration when developed
  - Shared with Public Health SG, Avsec/FAL SG and HQ SME
  - Seeking advice/guidance from SMEs
  - Not all vaccines require temperature control – HQ SME is researching
  - From a safety viewpoint, hopefully, dry ice is not used
  - Further discussion for next SG meetings.
