CIVIL AIRCRAFT SAR TRAINING COURSE

SUMMARY

This paper presents information on a Search and Rescue training course held in 2019.

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 To promote the learning on search and rescue of civil aircraft status, improve the efficiency of search and rescue working, increase the civil aviation emergency disposal ability, air traffic management office CAAC held a SAR training course. A total of 50 staff who are responsible for civil aircraft SAR working from the government departments, ATC operation department, civil aviation colleges attended the training.

2. DISCUSSION

Training Content

2.1 The course invited international aircraft SAR experts to give lectures on the maritime SAR, aircraft positioning technology, and actual SAR cases.

2.2 Experts from the China Maritime Search and Rescue Center were invited to explain the domestic maritime search and rescue of civil aircraft.

2.3 The course included a case of a search and rescue in the western region of China in 2018, which was explained by the person in charge of this search and rescue operation. This case was presented as a working paper at the fourth meeting of the ICAO Asia/Pacific Search and Rescue Working Group (APSAR/WG/4) in 2019.
