# Air Traffic Management

Air Traffic Management (ATM) plays a vital role in global air connectivity by ensuring the safety and efficiency of flights.

It is the crucial lubricant that keeps airlines flying safely and efficiently between our airports.

While largely invisible to the travelling public and decision makers its importance to aviation cannot be overemphasised.



# Air Navigation Service Providers (ANSPs) are...

Losing revenue with air traffic down by almost 70% in the Asia Pacific

- But they must maintain airspace availability for the aircraft that are still flying
- And must avoid cutting costs that will jeopardize the recovery when it comes, such as laying off essential staff or cancelling essential projects

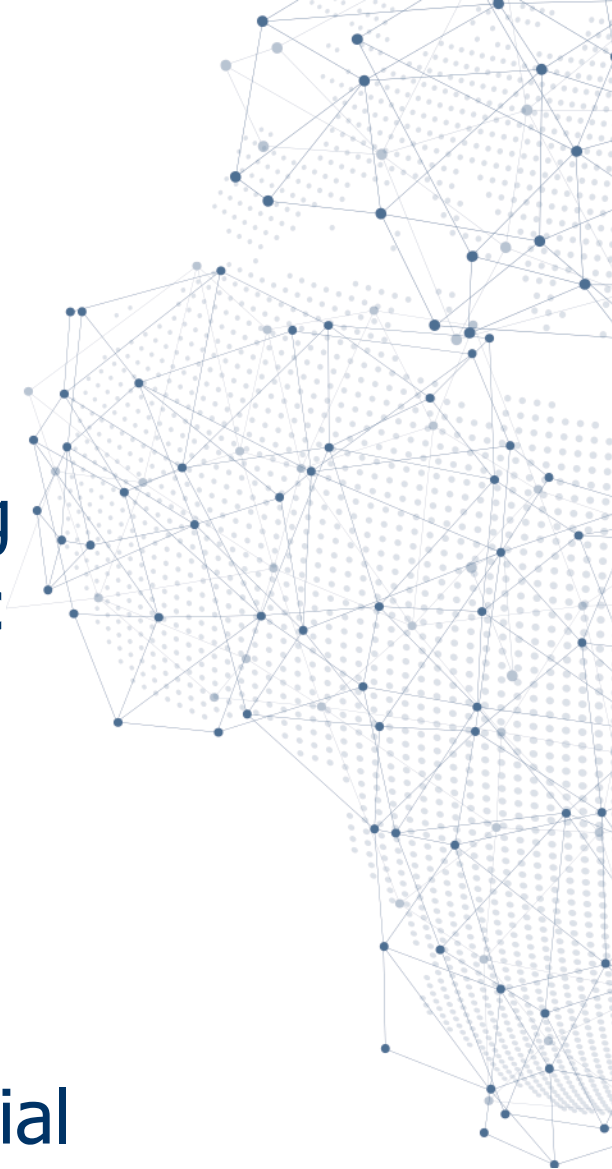
# ANSP recovery planning

- Contingency planning – must evolve the current business continuity measures to handle rising traffic levels
- Regional planning – must enhance industry collaboration and regional collaborative decision making (CDM) as traffic growth will be less predictable.
- Business planning – ANSPs must be considered in industry relief



# Recovery

- Much uncertainty remains – when and how fast
- Operational complexities will vary greatly depending on how long the downturn lasts and how fast traffic resumption occurs
- Shape and pace of recovery may be different in different regions and in different parts of a region
- Information sharing and industry-wide coordination and cooperation with state regulators will be essential



# Important for ICAO to....

- Lead the development of consistent standards and principles and ensure mutual recognition
- Be a platform for global coordination for the safe and efficient restart of aviation activity
- Support public confidence
- Safeguard aviation's role in supporting economic recovery regionally and globally



# Conclusion

- Getting aircraft flying again will require close coordination across the entire aviation industry.
