SUMMARY

This paper review updating process and coordination procedure for aeronautical facilities and services operating in the Frequency List No. 1 and Frequency List No. 2.

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 Indonesia is an archipelago country that has many airports, so the number of airports is directly proportional with the number of CNS facilities, and all the frequency allocations for those facilities are regularly reported to the ICAO. Considering the numbers of frequency list that Indonesia have, it takes more time and effort to report all those frequencies. In general, the efficient of process to update the Frequency List is becoming crucial.

1.2 Unlike other frequency list, coordination and assignment for Frequency List No. 3 is already using ICAO tools named Frequency Finder. Meanwhile, assignment for Frequency List No. 1 and 2 are still going through the State letter, and the update list is published by ICAO through the documents.

2. DISCUSSION

2.1 Through State Letter No. T 8/8.4, 8.5 & 8.6:AP006/16 (CNS) dated January 14th 2016, ICAO Regional Office for APAC delivered a letter regarding the Frequency List No. 1, 2 and 3. Following up that State Letter, Indonesia responded by sending an update of the frequency list for CNS facilities through State Letter Ref. AU.306/4/13/DJPU-DNP.2016 dated April 12th 2016. In the attachment of that letter, there are 175 frequency allocations for Frequency List No. 1, and 135 frequency allocations for Frequency List No. 2.

2.2 On April 1st 2020 by State Letter Ref. T 8/8.4 & T 8/8.5: AP090/20 (CNS), ICAO inform state members that Frequency Lists have been updated and published through documents Frequency List No. 1 Thirty-Fourth edition and Frequency List No. 2 Thirty-Third edition.

2.3 However, there are differences in the numbers of data from those documents compared to frequency allocation which has been reported by Indonesia in 2016. In details, document Frequency List No. 1 Thirty-Fourth edition is contained by 109 frequency allocations, and Frequency List No. 2 is contained by 47 frequency allocations.
