ATM safety assessment in change management (a three-day session)

 Content: As safety is prerequisite when planning implementation of air navigation operational improvement, ICAO Annex 11 and Doc4444(PANS-ATM) require that any significant safety-related change to the ATS system shall only be effected after a safety assessment has demonstrated that an acceptable level of safety will be met and users have been consulted, and post-implementation monitoring needs to be conducted to verify that the defined level of safety continues to be met.  
 One of the challenges faced by States and ANSPs is the lack of guidelines, expertise and relevant hands-on experience on how to conduct safety assessment when implementing safety-related changes in ATM. In its role to assist States in implementing change in ATM, the ICAO APAC Regional Office and Sub-Office (APAC RSO) support our member States by providing a forum to expand knowledge and share experience and best practices for the improvement of ATM performance while ensuring safety.  
 Objectives:
 
  - To improve understanding of all stakeholder' responsibilities for safety assessment in ATM
  - To enhance understanding of all stakeholders on the ICAO requirements needed for global and regional planning and implementation activities in ANS and aviation safety.
  - To enhance State's ATM safety assessment capability by providing some guidance on methodology and giving a forum to share practical experience and best practices so that APAC States and ANSPs can plan more effective implementation of change management in ATM system.
