**SUMMARY**

This Working Paper presents a list of Generic Guidance Materials developed by AP-WHM/WG and approved by APANPIRG AOP/SG and discuss the need for identification of custodian for review and periodic updates of these Guidance Materials.

**1. INTRODUCTION**

1.1 In accordance with the AP-WHM/WG Task List, the Working Group has developed a number of Generic Guidance Materials (GGMs) for use/reference by States/Administrations and approved by APANPIRG AOP/SG for management of wildlife hazards on or in the vicinity of aerodrome.

2.1 The list of GGMs developed by AP-WHM/WG and approved by APANPIRG AOP/SG is provided in the Table below:

For this purpose, it is necessary to identify dedicated person(s) of the organization(s) with responsibility to review and update the respective APAC GGM(s) in coordination with ICAO APAC Office whenever it becomes necessary.

2.3 The Secretariat will develop a process with the triggering event for review and update of the APAC GGM(s), which would be applicable to all Working Group(s) and Task Force under APANPIRG AOP/SG once approved by AOP/SG.
