**REVIEW OF THE DECISIONS AND CONCLUSIONS BY RASG-APAC AND APRAST**

*(Presented by Secretariat)*

**SUMMARY**

This Paper presents updates of the progress on the RASG-APAC/11 Decisions and Conclusions and APRAST/18 Decisions and Conclusions held in VTC from Bangkok, Thailand in 24-27 January 2022 and 20-24 June 2022 respectively.

Action by the meeting is in paragraph 3.0 below.

**1. INTRODUCTION**

1.1 This paper presents updates of the progress and status of Decisions and Conclusions adopted at RASG-APAC/11 held in VTC from Bangkok, Thailand in 24-27 January 2022 and status of Decisions and Conclusions adopted at APRAST/18 held in VTC from Bangkok, Thailand in 20-24 June 2022.

**2. DISCUSSION**

2.1 RASG-APAC/11 adopted eight Decisions and three Conclusions and all are 'Proposed to be Closed'. Status of the RASG-APAC/11 Decisions and Conclusions can be found in **Attachment A** to this paper.
