Exclusion: Minibar, personal expenses in room, business center service, service charge of the hotel and VAT.

***Kindly note that it is subject to availability and occupancy at the selected hotel. Cost of accommodation including cancellation charges, telecommunications charges and other services provided by the hotel are to be borne by the delegates.**



3. Transfer Services

- a. Delegates should make their own transportation arrangement upon arrival in and departure from Bali. Most of the hotels run their transfer service to and from the airport. Public transportation is easily accessible at the checkpoints and the hotels.
- b. The Help Desk of APANPIRG/33 Meeting will be available on the arrival terminal.
- c. Delegates are advised to keep the Meeting Secretariat duly informed of their confirmed flight schedules and accommodation to assist the arrangement the airport transfers accordingly.

4. Passport and Visa Requirements

- a. All visitors to Indonesia must hold a valid Passport or internationally recognised Travel Document valid for travel to Indonesia. The documents shall be valid and still valid for at least 6 (six) months the date of entry. Foreign nationals who require a Visa to enter Indonesia must apply and obtain a Visa in advance at any Indonesian Representative Office abroad before entering the country.
- b. Usual visa on arrival services in Indonesia were suspended during the COVID-19 pandemic, however the VOA has been reinstated for citizens of all eligible nations.
- c. All passengers must meet all other entry requirements to be eligible for a VOA, including any coronavirus measures. Travelers should check the most recent Indonesia COVID-19 restrictions before their trip.

5. Travel to Bali, Indonesia

- a. Ngurah Rai International Airport, Bali (DPS/WADD), also known as Denpasar International Airport, operates 24 hours a day, provide direct flight to a number of destination city around the world. It normally takes 25 minutes from the airport to the meeting venue.
- b. Please arrange with your hotel for transfer service to and from airport. Plenty of public transportations are available; you can choose a fixed-fare prepared taxi or taxi meter. For fixed-fare prepared taxi, just go to the ticketing booth, normally after the arrival gate and buy a fixed-fare ticket. For taxi meter, you can find outside the airport gate. Better choice and most reliable taxi meter company is Bali Taxi, also known as Blue Bird Taxi.

6. Currencies and Credit Cards

- a. The currency is Indonesian Rupiah (IDR): (1 USD \approx 14.875 IDR).
- b. The Indonesia Rupiah (IDR) is the official local currency. Most shops will convert US Dollar, or other currencies, to Indonesia Rupiah.

Use only an authorized money changer, a formal bank or ask your hotel for money exchange and always ask for a receipt.

The charge commission is various rate depend on the changers policies, always ask first about their rate offered and charge commission. Avoid changing money in smaller currency exchange offices located within shops.

- c. International credit cards such as American Express, Diners Club, Visa, Master, etc, are usually accepted at major hotels, shops and restaurants. You will need small change in the Indonesia Rupiah for local transport and others.
- d. Most major commercial banks have branches in the main tourist centers. Banking hours are generally from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday to Friday.

There are many ATM (Automatic Teller Machines) all over the place, especially at shopping centers and bank branches. Most of them are connected to international banking networks. ATMs dispense Indonesia Rupiah (IDR) only, and it comes in either IDR 50,000 and IDR 100,000 notes

7. Time

The time in Bali, known as WITA or Waktu Indonesia Tengah, is 8 hours ahead of Coordinated Universal Time (UTC + 8).

8. Climate and weather

November is probably among the delightful months of the year in Bali. The average temperature is expected to be 27 to 31 degrees Celsius respectively.

From December to March, the west monsoon can bring heavy showers and high humidity, but days are still often sunny with the rains starting in the late afternoon or evening and passing quickly. From June to September, the humidity is low and it can be quite cool in the evenings. At this time of the year there is hardly any rain in the lowland coastal areas.

Even when it is raining across most of Bali, you can often enjoy sunny, dry days on the Bukit Peninsula which receives far less rain than any other part of the island. On the other hand, in central Bali and in the mountains, you should not be surprised by cloudy skies and showers at any time of the year.

9. Tap Water

Tap water in Bali is not drinkable, but bottled water is universally available. Just be certain that the bottle has an intact plastic seal. Tap water in hotels should not be used for drinking unless explicitly labelled as safe or drinkable.

10. Electricity

The power plugs and sockets are of type C and F. The standard voltage is 230 V and the standard frequency is 50 Hz.



11. COVID-19

- a. All foreign travelers (foreign nationals) entering the territory of the Republic of Indonesia shall adjust their travel documents to ensure compliance with the provisions regarding the foreign travelers allowed to enter the territory of the Republic Indonesia, which includes **Covid-19 vaccination certificates**, and the use of **PeduliLindungi application**.
- b. Upon arrival at the entry points, foreign travelers must undergo a Covid-19 symptoms check, including a body temperature check, with the following conditions:
 - 1) If there is no symptom of Covid-19 and body temperature is below 37.5 degrees Celsius: **RT-PCR examination upon arrival is not required.**
 - 2) If there is any symptom of Covid-19 or body temperature above 37.5 degrees Celsius: **RT-PCR examination upon arrival is mandatory.**
- c. The provision regarding the period of isolation (quarantine) applies for all foreign travelers with the following categories:
 - 1) Quarantine is no longer required for those who have received the complete dose of vaccine at least 14 days before the departure time.
 - 2) Quarantine period of 5 x 24 hours is required for those who have not been vaccinated or received the complete dose of vaccine.
