## **Additional Information**

1. The Philippine government currently applies COVID-19 requirements to travelers entering from outside of the country. Please be advised that beginning 0001H of 02 December 2022, upon arrival in the Philippines, please access the Philippine One-Stop Electronic Travel Declaration System thru this link: <a href="https://etravel.gov.ph/">https://etravel.gov.ph/</a>.

To avoid long lines at the airport, we highly encourage you to fill out the e-Travel Registration within 72 hours prior to departure from your country of origin.

If you are unable to do so before departure, personnel from the Philippine Bureau of Quarantine (BOQ) and airport staff will assist you in completing and uploading the e-Travel Registration upon your arrival in the Philippines.

- 2. Part of the host's airport courtesies, the Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines (CAAP) will provide transportation to the participants from the airport to the hotels and vice versa. For easy coordination and reference, kindly email your flight details to and from the Philippines and hotel booking details to <a href="mailto:icacs@caap.gov.ph">icacs@caap.gov.ph</a>. A CAAP Security Officer will wait for you at the arrival hallway, just outside the boarding bridge, to fetch and escort you to your booked hotel.
- 3. In the Philippines, wearing facemasks is now voluntary in all indoor and outdoor spaces.
- 4. CAAP will offer a cultural tour at the Intramuros, Manila, at 2:00 p.m., 16 December 2022 (tentative plan).
