Agreed on deliverables for WS3

- Review and provide recommended edits regional guidance material (APAC Regional ATM Contingency Plan) on baseline operational contingency procedures as necessary (Completed)
- 2. Develop a regional 'How To' document for coordination procedures that can be used as an easy reference document by ANSPs;
- 3. Develop and/or review/edit Operational Contingency Plans (OCPs) for individual APAC ANSPs through collaboration with neighboring ANSPs, with support from the international organizations with a focus on how they can assist airspace partners when there is a contingency event, i.e. Continuity of Service (COS);
- 4. Exercise regional OCPs via table-top exercises;
- 5. Utilize an easily accessible electronic platform for sharing of OCPs as well as information/documents developed by other work streams;

- 5. Conduct contingency exercises (at least three)
 - Identify and address any remaining gaps
- 6. Finalize WS3 activities prior to DGCA/59 (October 2024)
