RELEVANT OUTCOMES OF ATFM/SG/13 AND AAITF/18

SUMMARY

This paper presents the outcomes of the Thirteenth meeting of Air Traffic Flow Management Steering Group (ATFM/SG/13) and the Eighteenth meeting of Aeronautical Information Services – Aeronautical Information Management Implementation Task Force (AAITF/18) relevant to Aerodrome Operations and Planning Sub Group (AOP/SG).

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 The Thirteenth Meeting of Air Traffic Flow Management Steering Group (ATFM/SG/13) was held in Bangkok, Thailand from 03 to 07 April 2023.

1.2 The Eighteenth Meeting of the ICAO Aeronautical Information Services (AIS) – Aeronautical Information Management (AIM) Implementation Task Force (AAITF/18) was held from 19 to 23 June 2023 at the ICAO Asia and Pacific Regional Office in Bangkok, Thailand.

2. DISCUSSION

A-CDM Implementation – Regional Monitoring Scheme

2.1 ICAO presented a brief on Airport Collaborative Decision-Making (A-CDM) implementation in the Asia/Pacific (APAC) Region, and a proposal to develop an annual regional monitoring and reporting scheme for the elements of the Asia/Pacific A-CDM Implementation Plan, noting that there was currently no mechanism for States to report implementation progress.

2.2 ATFM/SG/13 was reminded of the ASBU (Aviation System Block Upgrades) elements of the GANP (Global Air Navigation Plan) related to A-CDM and Network Operations (NOPS), elements A-CDM- B0/1, B0/2, B1/1, and NOPS-B0/4, B1/3.

2.3 It was agreed to develop an annual regional monitoring and reporting scheme for the elements of the Asia Pacific A-CDM Implementation Plan and the task to be undertaken by the ATFM Information Requirements Small Working Group (ATFM/IR/SWG) of ATFM/SG.

2.4 The Chair reminded the ATFM/IR/SWG members to include A-CDM experts in the ATFM/IR/SWG for this task. IATA suggested that Airport Council International (ACI) might also be included in this matter, which was agreed by the meeting.

AAITF/18

2.5 AAITF/18 was informed that the Tenth Meeting of the Air Traffic Management Sub-Group of APANPIRG (ATM/SG/10, Video Teleconference, 17 to 21 October 2022) had raised an Action Item responding to a request by AOP/SG/6 that ATM/SG assist in encouraging States to comply with requirements for publication of aerodrome certification status in the Aeronautical Information Publication (AIP). The Action Item was added to the AAITF Task List, for follow-up AIS action by all Asia/Pacific (APAC) Region Administrations (**Table 1**):
