## DISCUSSION

### ■ Route Progress 2023

- ✓ 11 routes discussed: 4 progressed, 5 newly proposed
- ✓ Remaining routes unchanged

### ■ Main Achievement: BOB01 Route

- ✓ Special meeting on May 11, 2023
- ✓ Agreement reached with Bangladesh, India, IATA
- ✓ Bi-directional route saves 55NM, benefits ~110 weekly flights

## Summary of Working Paper

- The ICAO Asia and Pacific (APAC) Office updated the Asia/Pacific Region ATS Route Catalogue, now available as Version 22.2.
  - ✓ The revision focuses on high-benefit proposals and archives others for future potential.
  - ✓ Out of thirty-nine routes discussed this year, eleven were examined, with four progressing, five newly introduced, and others remaining unchanged.
- A highlight is the consensus on establishment of the BOB01 Route in the Bay of Bengal, conserving about 55NM and benefitting approximately 110 weekly flights.

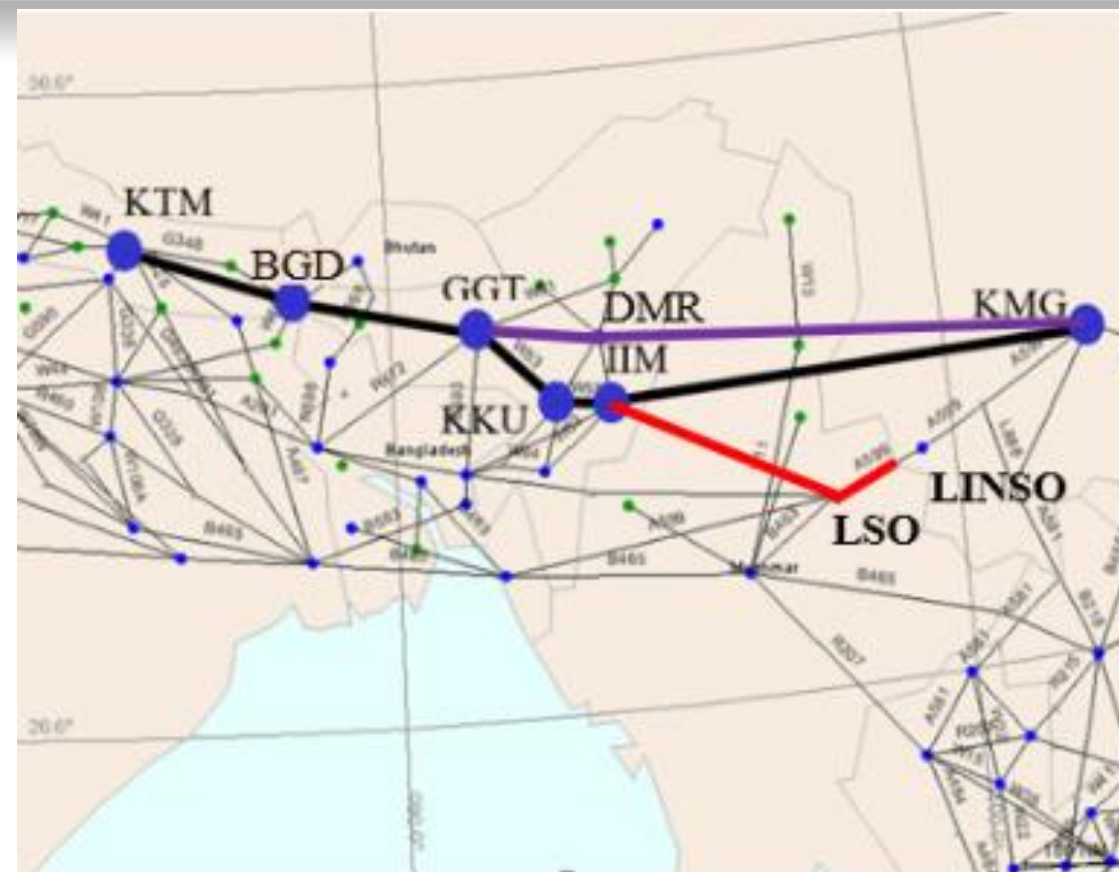

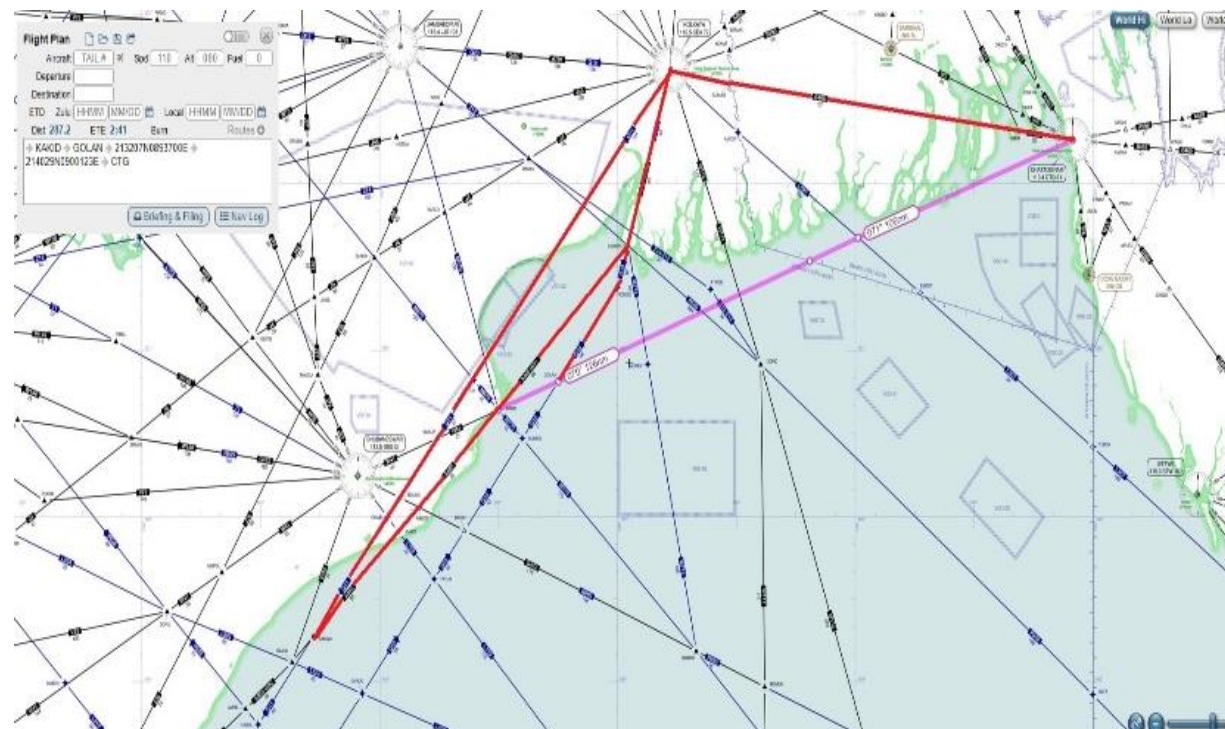




## BOB 01
