



COVID – 19 TIMELINE

- 31 Dec 2019 first case reported
- 07 Jan 2020 NCov -19 virus identified
- 10 Jan 2020 NCov-19 genomics shared to vaccine scientist
- 27 Jan 2020 MAG introduces face mask to Cabin Crew
- 30 Jan 2020 WHO declares PHEIC
- 30 Jan 2020 MAG declares Code Yellow
- 11 Feb 2020 COVID-19 named
- 11 Mar 2020 WHO declares Pandemic
- 16 Mar 2020 MAG declares Code Amber
- 18 Mar 2020 1st Malaysian Lockdown
- 24 Apr 2020 1st Case in MAG
- Oct 2020 Vaccine announced in US/UK
- 05 Oct 2020 1st MAG death
- 18 Feb 2021 Vaccine launched in Malaysia
- Mar 2021 Delta variant detected in Malaysia
- May 2021 Delta variant surge
- 05 Jul 2021 1st Vaccine for Airline Workers
- 10 Nov 2021 100% vaccine among MAG active crew
- Nov 2021 Omicron virus in Malaysia
- Feb 2022 Gradual reopening of borders
- Apr 2022 Full reopening of borders
- Sep 2022 Face mask optional for passenger
- 05 May 2023 WHO announces end of PHEIC
- 28 Jul 2023 Malaysia ends most measures
- 15 Sep 2023 MAG crew removes face mask



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
