I. Background

- The No Country Left Behind (NCLB) initiative highlights ICAO's efforts to assist States in implementing ICAO Standards and Recommended Practices (SARPs). The main goal of this work is to help ensure that SARP implementation is better harmonized globally so that all States have access to the significant socioeconomic benefits of safe and reliable air transport.
- Due to the outsource maintenance service provider was sudden terminated in early 2022 and caused the impact to maintenance issued of some CNS system (Communications, Navigation, Surveillance, ATM automation, AIS-AIM, simulator, etc.)
- In March 2022, consulted and contacted with ICAO APAC CNS Officer via E-mail stating and asking for the assistance (Challenging situation of Lao ANSP)

II. Project Start up

- Discussion had been continued via e-mail until CNS Officer of ICAO APAC proposed 3 solutions and the best solution was selected "seek support of neighboring ANSP to establish spare parts sharing and technician training mechanism with appropriate funding source" (Thanks to member' state support "ATMB"
- 4 prominent subjects: RADAR/ADS-B, VCCS, AMHS/IT network and ATM AS were identified
- High level of ICAO APAC office and DCA Lao/LANS met virtually in July for further possibility
- Since then there were 7 online meetings between ICAO APAC officers, CAAC/ATMB (coordinators and SME) and DCAL/LANS (Coordinators and Technicians)

Project Concept

- One proposal addressed the sustainable operation of the CNS/ATM infrastructure in Lao PDR, through collaboration with capable neighboring ANSP in terms of spare parts sharing and personnel training, as part of ATM capability building.
- Specific training support for Radar/ADS-B, Automation system (Topsky), AMHS/Network Switch, SCHMID VCCS ICS200/60 for 26 technicians in 4 classes
- Evaluation on maintenance, integration and planning capability for future.

Project Objectives

- The project is meant to achieve the following:
- 1) Improved maintenance capability of Lao ANSP.
- 2) Produce an evaluation report to identify the current gap and proposals for future actions.
- 3) Improved engagement of ICAO APAC RO and Lao ANSP in CNS/ATM infrastructure area.
- 4) Improved engagement of ICAO APAC RO and member's state (China ATMB) in supporting regional initiative in terms of expertise and other resources.



Summary:

Process:

- Kick off meeting and first SME on Radar and VCCS started from 12 December 2022 to 6 January 2023 in Vientiane, Lao PDR
- Second SME on ATM AS and AMHS/IT Network started from 5 February to 3 March 2023
- Project Wrap-Up Meeting on 3 March 2023
- Final Report completed in July 2023

Key points:

- DCA Lao is doing their obligation to oversight for ensuring the ANSP comply with standards by the way conveying the support from ICAO to enhance ANSP's (LANS) maintenance capability with suitable level to ensure the safety of Air Traffic Services
- LANS Technicians knowledge and skills have been improved in certain level and will keep on developing and encourage to achieve at higher level.
- LANS's critical systems were evaluated the need to be upgraded and risks were identified that need to be solved timely
- Tighten the cooperation between ICAO APAC RO and member's state.
