ADDITION OF NEW PACKAGE D+ IN CRV

(Presented by the Secretariat)

SUMMARY

The paper presents the details of new package D+ and proposed to add them in the current CRV common packages for meeting review and adoption.

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 The Ninth Meeting of the Common aeRonautical Virtual Private Network Operations Group of APANPIRG (CRV OG/9) was held from 25 to 27 January 2022 via Video Tele-Conference (VTC). The Meeting was attended by 119 participants from 21 Member States/Administrations, 1 International Organization, and 1 Industry. 1.2 The Tenth Meeting of the Common aeRonautical Virtual Private Network Operations Group of APANPIRG (CRV OG/10) was held on 18 April 2022 via Video Tele-Conference (VTC). The meeting was attended by 89 participants from 21 Member States/Administrations and 1 Industry. 1.3 In CRV OG/9, IP/13 was presented by France for sharing the CRV implementation status in France. The paper shared Package D+ as the Step 1b for New-Caledonia. In the same meeting, IP/10 was presented by Mongolia mentioning Package D+.

1.4 This paper summarized relevant information and updates for Package D+.

2. DISCUSSION

2.1 In CRV OG/9, IP/10 presented by Mongolia and IP/13 presented by France shared two concepts for Package D+.

2.2 Mongolia informed the CRV OG/9 meeting that Mongolia planned to add two lines as a main and backup with two ISP while implementing Package D+. CRV OG Chair (Asia) informed that there is no package D+ in CRV packages offered to Member States. Therefore, Package D+ may be considered as Package D with additional backups. The meeting agreed to the need to formalise the new Package D+ in the Common Package Documentation.

2.3 The CRV OG Experts Ad Hoc meeting held on 14 April 2022, 15 September 2022 and 16 December 2022 discussed and finalized the definition and formalization process of Package D+.

2.4 The list of documents to be updated in CRV Common Packages after the endorsement of Package D+ definition by CRV OG/11 would be:

- 1) Addendum to Terms And Conditions between PCCW Global and CRV Authority v3
- 2) High-Level Individual Site Questionnaire v2.2
- 3) PCCWG_System Design Document v4.6
- 4) Service Order Form (v2)
- 5) CRV Operations Manual

2.5 The finalized definition and updated CRV common packages to include the new Package D+ is being presented **by PCCWG by the WP/08 to the meeting.**
