FLEXIBILITY IN CRV CONTRACT RENEWAL

SUMMARY

This paper presents a proposal to provide another level of flexibility for contract renewal.

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 The signing of the CRV Contract with the Service providers provides for an initial five year agreement and then ongoing one-year renewals to a maximum of ten years.

2. DISCUSSION

- 2.1 The CRV OG Operations Manual states:

The terms of the contract with CRV SERVICE PROVIDER Global, the CRV Service Provider, was set for an initial Five Years with Five additional One-year contract additions totalling a Ten-year contractual agreement until 31st December 2027.

- 2.2 There is an overhead to managing rolling one-year renewals, a different degree of flexibility is required.

- 2.3 With some states approaching the five-year anniversary of their contracts with PCCWG, questions are being asked about the ability to sign for different periods of time.

- 2.4 It is proposed that the CRV OG Operations Manual is updated to allow contract extensions of two or three year.

- 2.5 The new wording will be:

The terms of the contract with the CRV SERVICE PROVIDER is set for an initial Five Years with additional One-year, Two year or Three year contract additions until 31st December 2028.

Note: The terms of the contract with the CRV SERVICE PROVIDER was set for an initial Five Years with Five additional One-year contract additions totalling a Ten-year contractual agreement until 31st December 2027.

APANPIRG/33/7 approved a contract extension of one year.
