**ICAO APAC Safety Seminar on SSP Implementation**

(02 to 04 August 2023)

ICAO RO, as a follow up to the Decisions RASG-APAC 12/11, has taken an initiative to organize a three day Safety Seminar on the subject and title of *sharing experience and challenges by the States in the implementation of SSP Journey*. Six States/Administration, as indicated below, have kindly accepted the ICAO invitation to share their experience on their SSP journey in the three day seminar:

1. Australia;
2. Hong Kong, China;
3. India;
4. Republic of Korea;
5. Singapore; and
6. United States.

Key objective of the Safety Seminar is to share the important Mile-stones in their safety implementation journey in details to support the other States in APAC Region. Further, presenter States have also agreed to share what challenges could be the anticipated and how and what strategies were adopted in overcoming such challenges, in accomplishing their journey. Additionally, attending State representatives would have a vivid learning opportunities from the six presenter states how different methodologies have been adopted by each presenting States in each of the theme topics above. Activity being an on-site Seminar, participants also may have a great opportunity to learn from other participant States and peers as well as net-working with others.

Seminar is planned as an on-site activity and would be held in ICAO Conference hall facility. Six Presenter States would combined together to present each State experience and to follow it up with an extensive Q&A session in the form of a panel discussion, based on the following five themes:

1. Introduction to the journey;
2. State Safety policy and objectives;
3. State Safety risk management;
4. State Safety assurance; and
5. State Safety promotion.

Seminar is also expected to help develop best practices within the APAC Region in support of the ongoing work of ICAO in terms of amendments made in relevant guidance materials as well as the development of their specific NASPs.

The Seminar will have four sessions for the first two days and two sessions on the third day. Each session will be between 60-90 minutes.
