I have the honour to invite your State/Administration/Organization to participate in the Thirteenth Meeting of the Regional Aviation Safety Group – Asia and Pacific Regions (RASG-APAC/13) which will be held at the Hong Kong Civil Aviation Department (HKCAD) Headquarters Auditorium in Hong Kong, China from 18-19 December 2023.
