SUMMARY

This paper presents the AMHS/CRV Implementation status Information in Asia/Pacific Region updated in AMC.

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 ATS Messaging Management Centre (AMC) is implemented by EUROCONTROL to provide off-line network management services in support of the ground ATS Messaging network of Air Navigation Service Providers (ANSPs). The key functions of the AMC are address management and routing management. It integrates the Aeronautical Fixed Telecommunications Network (AFTN), the Common ICAO Data Interchange Network (CIDIN) and the ATS Message Handling System (AMHS) to transparently deliver operational ATS Messages on a global basis.

1.2 Thailand, by AEROTHAI on behalf of the Asia/Pacific COM Centres perform as the regional focal point to update the AFTN/AMHS information via AMC website based on the AIRAC cycle.

2. DISCUSSION

2.1 Following the AMHS and Common aeRonautical VPN (CRV) connections updated in AMC (OPER 259) on 22 FEB 2024, the information is as in **Attachment A** to this paper.
