


Reminder: What is BOBCAT?





Demand-capacity balancing service for westbound traffic over Kabul FIR between 2000 – 2359 UTC, provided by Bangkok ATFMU since 2007





Reminder: What happened in Aug 2021?

(NewsHub x Flightradar24)

> August 2021:

- ➤ Withdrawal of U.S. & coalition forces
- > Suspension of ATS provision over Kabul FIR
- Activation of Kabul FIR CCT
- "Zero" overflights since 16 Aug 21

- > September 2021:
 - BOBCAT ATFM service suspended

Recommended "Time to Resume Service": 3 - 4 Months
