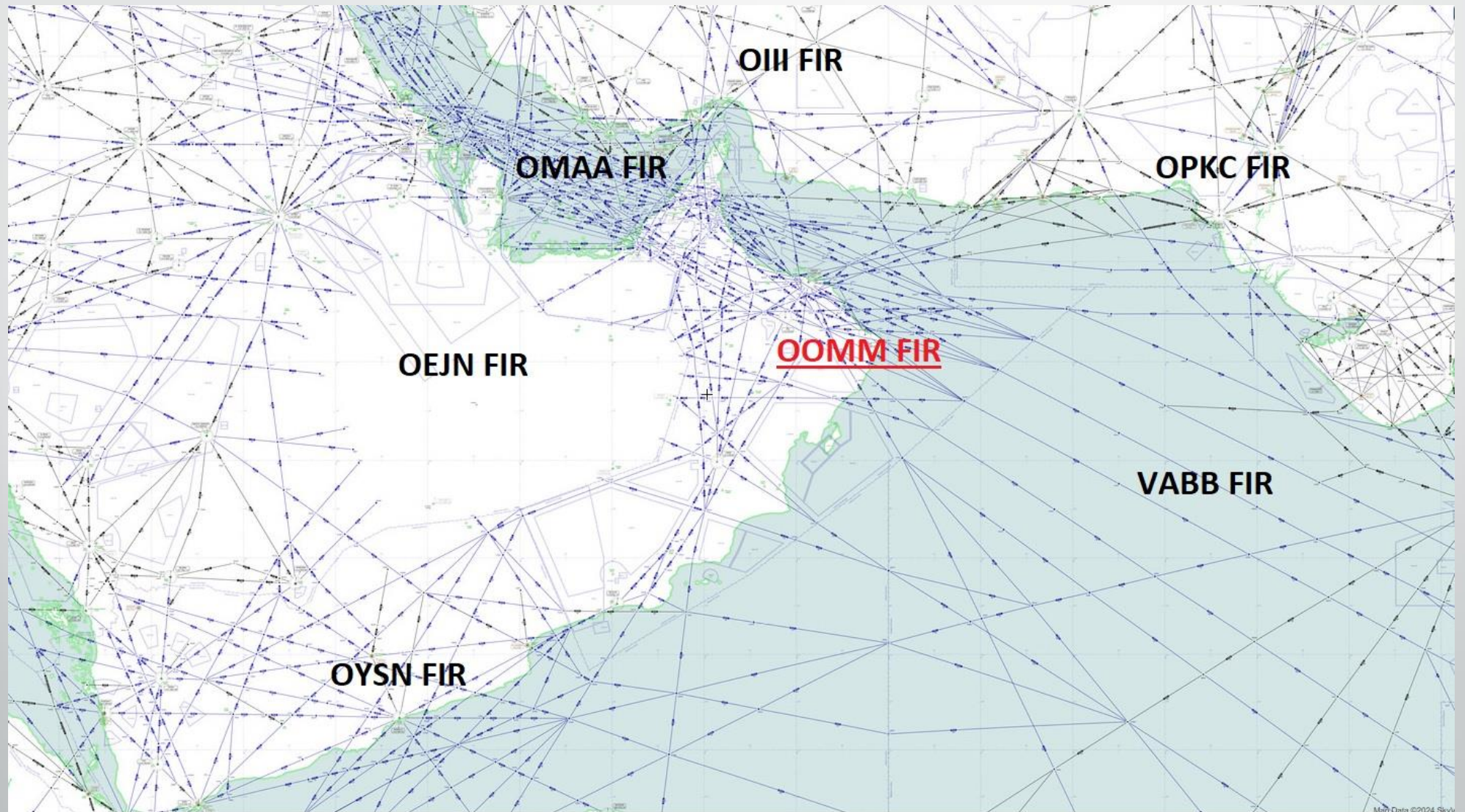

Oman has been affected by several Storms & cyclones almost yearly

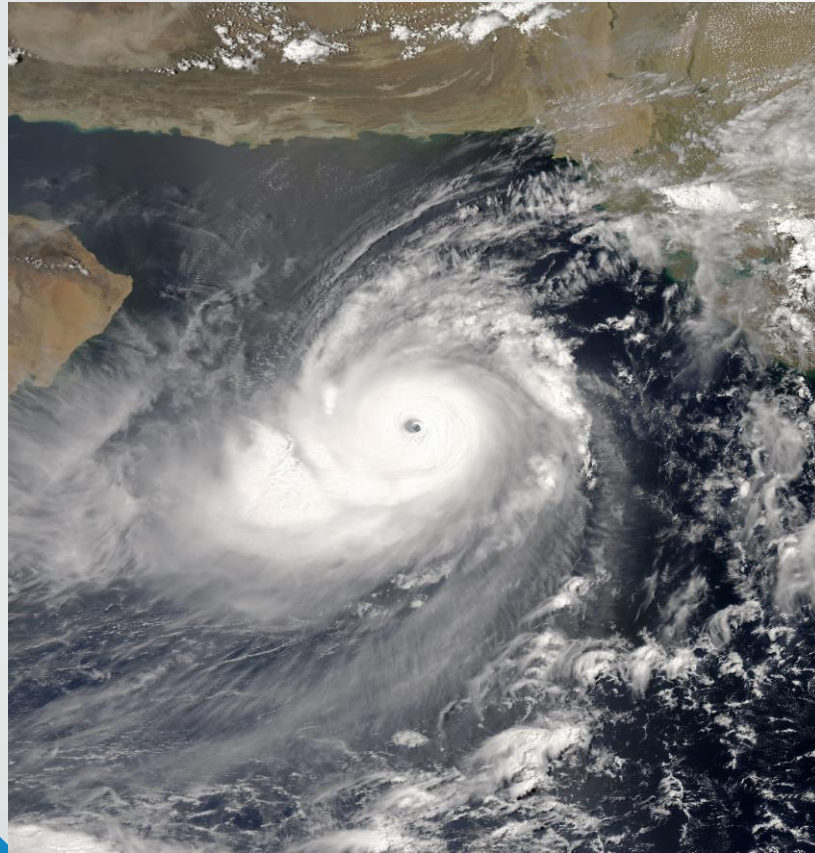
Which had a major impact on the Aviation Sector.

Gonu (June - 2007)

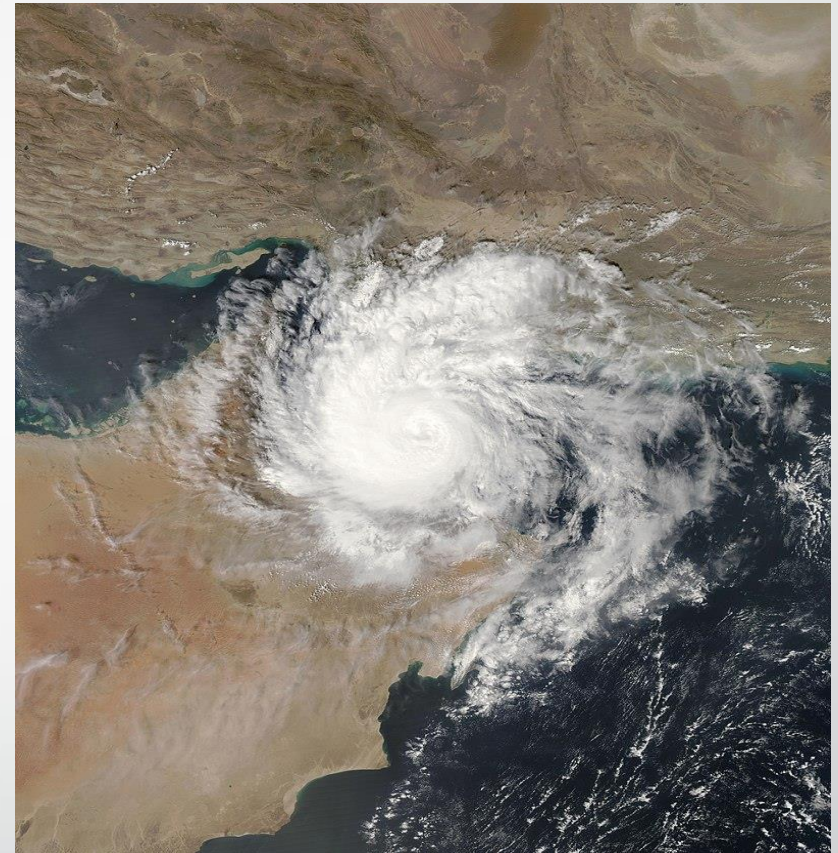
Which affected the Northern Parts Of Oman

Impact Of Cyclone Gonu

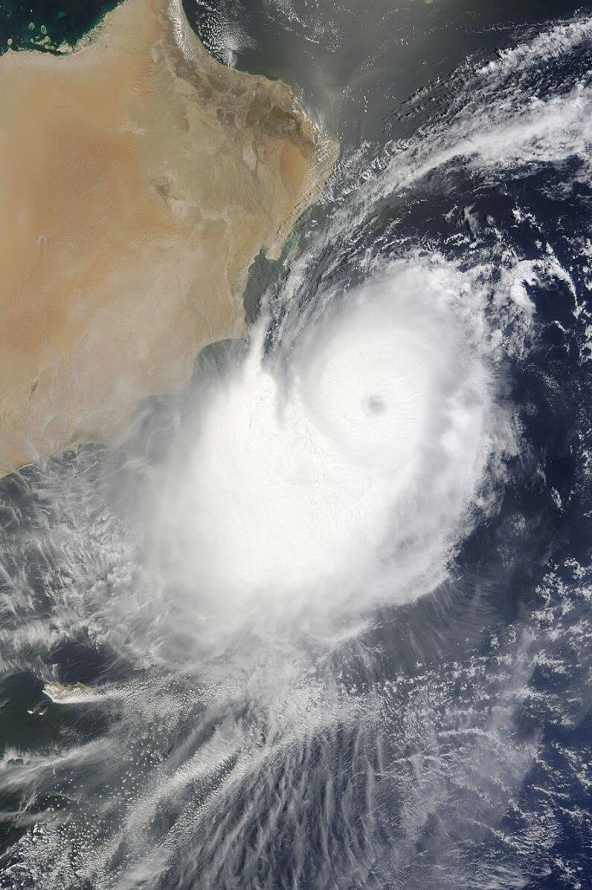
- First super cyclonic storm in the Arabian Sea on record.
- Total deaths of approximately 50 & Injured 2000
- 25,000 Houses / 13,000 Cars Destroyed
- Air traffic was fully disrupted for almost 72 Hours.



Lesson Learnt From Super Cyclone Gonu:

- Oman Government Invested Millions To Improve:
CNS & ATM infrastructure:
 - New ATM Building
 - New ATM System INDRA
 - CTC Established
 - New RADARs stations And VHF Radios with STANDBY SYSTEM.
- Training & Awareness Were Conducted.
- Coordination process with National MET Department working together and providing the latest updates.

Cyclone Shaheen (OCT – 2021)



Contingency & Coordination Team Established:

- Follow Up With MET department for latest update & Information.
- Staffing Preparation & Readiness
- Ensuring Equipment Ready & Backed up

Impacts:

- No Airspace Closure
- Sever Weather Deviations
