
Logistics

Panel Decisions

- 4/1 Manual on Trust Framework Implementation
 - Begin development on a manual on trust framework implementation, and propose the necessary amendments to the job card to the ANC
- 5/1 Inter-Panel Task Force
 - Proposes the formation of an inter-panel task force with the Cybersecurity Panel to enhance coordination on development of common guidance materials
- 5/2 Manual on Information Security
 - Requests the Secretariat to process the draft Manual on Information Security as amended by the meeting, according to the agreed arrangements and schedule



Panel Recommendations

- 3/1 SBAS Authentication
 - Support the NSP by developing the necessary certificate profiles for SBAS authentication
- 3/2 NSP Coordination
 - Recommend the Identity Management Working Group have a joint teleconference with the NSP SBAS Authentication Ad-hoc to further discuss key management and out-of-band key distribution
- 4/1 MET Panel Coordination
 - Support the METP in their work on MET information security
- 5/1 Data Classification
 - Refer the contents of the working paper to the Cybersecurity Panel for their consideration
- 6/1 Job Card Amendments



Existing Inter-Panel Coordination

- Cybersecurity Panel (CYSECP)
 - Received informal comments on content from Doc 10204 Manual on Information Security
- IMP
 - Focus on finalizing Doc 10204 in support of PANS-IM
- CP-DCIWG
 - Very close ongoing coordination supporting Job Card CP-DCIWG.007
 - Alignment of Aviation Common Certificate Policy with Manual on PKI Policy for Aeronautical Communications (Doc 10095)
 - Alignment of Doc 10204 with Manual on Security Services for Aeronautical Communications



New Inter-Panel Coordination

- NSP
 - Technical assistance requested from TFP regarding SBAS authentication and key management
- METP
 - Technical assistance requested from TFP on MET information protection
- Joint teleconferences currently being organized between the Panels to initiate work

 TFP proposed new Inter-Panel Task Force with CYSECP to enhance coordination on development of common guidance materials
