ACTION: SEARAST 22/1

Preparation and conduct of COSCAP-SEA activities

During COVID-19 pandemic, the Meeting agreed to the following action:

- 1. COSCAP-SEA to support Member States using appropriate delivery mode (face-to-face, online or "hybrid" for its activities while seeking support from partners.
- 2. COSCAP-SEA Member States to reap benefits to enhance the State's Safety Oversight, AIG and SSP, as applicable:
 - providing inputs requested by COSCAP-SEA,
 - > ensuring the participation by the relevant personnel, and
 - > taking practical steps for implementation





ACTION: SEARAST 22/2

Development of periodic National Aviation Safety Plans

- 1. COSCAP-SEA to support States in developing NASPs, which includes SEIs for the considered period, and link to GASP and AP-RASP.
- 2. COSCAP-SEA Member States to take actions to:
 - a) develop periodic NASPs demonstrating State's strategy, priority of actions, clear goals, targets and indicators, and its links to the GASP and AP-RASP; and
 - b) monitor progress in the effective implementation of the SEIs contained in their NASPs and assess the effectiveness of those SEIs.

Discussed during Interim SEARAST, only 6 States have published and only 02 NASPs are current. Ongoing, Some States need more support form leading States.





ACTION: SEARAST 22/3

Implementation support solutions

- 1.COSCAP-SEA Member States to:
 - a) review, ICAO's Capacity Development and Implementation Bureau (CDI) products and services, and
 - b) identify the ones that support their short-, mid- and longer-term aviation safety needs.
- 2.COSCAP-SEA to support its States, as per approved work plan and as requested, in:
- a) identifying priority needs for implementation support, and
- b) liaise with CDI and the ICAO APAC Regional Office, to explore opportunities to address these needs in the most cost-effective, accessible, timely and user-friendly manner.

ACTION: SEARAST 22/4

Provision of data by States on the ICAO APAC SEI Monitoring Tools

- 1. COSCAP-SEA Member States to upload their data on the "ICAO APAC SEI Monitoring Tools.
- 2. COSCAP-SEA, in coordination with the ICAO APAC Regional Office, to report on its Member States' progress at the SCM/21 meeting.

ACTION: Interim SEARAST

Provision of data by States on the ICAO APAC SEI Monitoring Tools

- a) Delayed updates for want of username/password by some States. These credentials are provided by APAC-RO in coordination with CAA Bangladesh. The CTA/PC to coordinate to facilitate credentials for the SEI monitoring tool as a one-time measure.
- b) CTA /PC will develop and share a tracking matrix for COSCAP-SEA States for regular updates. This will be in addition to the requirements of updating the ICAO APAC SEI Monitoring Tool. The tracker is attached with this report.

- a) Action initiated
- b) A simple matrix (MS. Word) created and shared with all States.





ACTION: SEARAST 22/5

Priorities for COSCAP-SEA regional training activities in 2022/2023

- 1. States propose to COSCAP-SEA one priority regional training activity for the July 2022/June 2023 by 16 Dec 2021 based seven "COSCAP-SEA strategic priorities", it can be linked with AP-RASP and/or Beijing Declaration.
- 2. COSCAP-SEA, with due consideration to the regional training activities proposed by its Member States and continuing to make all possible use of synergies with COSCAP-SEA Partners, to establish a proposed 2022/2023 COSCAP-SEA work plan for presentation, review and approval at SCM/21.

Could not be completed, now WP 2024-25 is proposed.
