

FAA Asia-Pacific Capacity Building Goals

- Support safety enhancements in civil aviation to help civil aviation authorities create safer systems by:
 - Increasing training capabilities,
 - Promoting positive safety culture,
 - Promoting pilot mental health,
 - Partnering with regional organizations (e.g., ICAO, ASEAN, APEC) to enhance collaboration opportunities
 - Identifying needs to prioritize FAA assistance

Asia Pacific Regional Engagements

- DGCA 58/DP/8/07: REGIONAL REGULATOR-INDUSTRY COLLABORATION TO ENHANCE INSPECTOR CAPABILITY IN ASIA PACIFIC (Presented by ICAO Secretariat, Bangladesh, Thailand, and the United States)
 - Partnership to sponsor high-potential inspectors for the Government Safety Inspector (GSI) courses in South Asia and Southeast Asia.
 - Courses offered: Airworthiness (AIR), Operations (OPS), and Personnel Licensing (PEL)

Progress on GSI Training

GSI-AIR for South Asia: Complete

- November 5-23, 2023 (Bangladesh)
- Four participants each from Bangladesh, India,
 Nepal, and Pakistan (16 total)

GSI-AIR for Southeast Asia: Complete

- October 23- November 10, 2023 (Thailand)
- Four participants each from Indonesia, Malaysia,
 Thailand, and Vietnam (16 total)

Next Steps in GSI Training

- GSI OPS for South Asia
 - April 28- May 16, 2024 (Dhaka)
- GSI PEL for South Asia
 - July 21-August 8, 2024 (Dhaka)
- GSI OPS for Southeast Asia
 - May 6-14, 2024 (Bangkok)
- GSI PEL for Southeast Asia
 - July 15- August 3, 2024 (Bangkok)

Pacific Islands

- Conducting a multi-disciplinary needs assessment of civil aviation systems to support prioritization of future FAA assistance
- Initiate process to conduct evaluation of PASO's capabilities as a Regional Safety Oversight Organization, to enhance aviation safety in the Pacific Islands region
- Sharing Best Practices

- Accident Investigation Training at the Department of Transportation, Transportation Safety Institute (TSI) in Oklahoma, United States
- FAA will fund travel and cost of course for aviation professionals from across Asia Pacific
