FACILITATING THE AVAILABILITY OF INTER-REGIONAL OPMET

(Presented by China)

SUMMARY

This paper presents the necessity of facilitating the availability of inter-regional OPMETs and invites MET/IE WG to research on the ways to facilitate the availability of inter-regional OPMETs.

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 The ICAO APAC ROBEX Handbook categorizes OPMET exchanges into four distinct types, which are regional exchange - ROBEX scheme, inter-regional OPMET exchange, OPMET information exchange through the internet, and other forms of OPMET exchanges.

1.2 OPMETs for AOP and some non-AOP airports in the ICAO APAC region, as shown in the Appendixes A and B of ICAO APAC ROBEX Handbook, can be collected via AFTN; and some global OPMETs can be collected via WAFS services.

1.3 Moreover, when other OPMETs are required, RQM reports are disseminated to the RODBs to get them.

2. DISCUSSION

2.1 The OPMETs requested via RQM reports are mainly for airports in African, Middle Eastern and North American regions. The airports for which OPMETs are requested via RQM reports periodically by Beijing ROC are shown as below, and the number of such airports may increase along with the growth of international flights.
