Background

• The RCM TF conducted a needs survey to Asia Pacific States / Administrations in June 2023 to update on the needs of the region and sub-regions in capability development and training needs, post the COVID-19 pandemic covered areas in aviation safety, aviation security, air navigation services, human resource development, facilitation and environment and found safety and security remain a priority. In Addition, Capacity development for the Pacific Small Island Developing States remains crucial to uplift aviation safety and security standards in the sub-region. Regional Training Cooperation Framework Working Group initiative was established during 58th DGCA Conference as a resolution of that matter and will continue the training Need analysis in more detail and find the resolution.
