SUMMARY

This paper presents the consolidated Asia/Pacific Air Traffic (ATM) Contact List, including the list of Aeronautical Information Service (AIS) Points of Contact, for updating

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 In 2019 the ICAO Regional Office consolidated its various separate contact lists into a single consolidated ATM Points of Contact (POC) List. The List requires regular updating to ensure up-to-date points of contact are recorded.

2. DISCUSSION

- 2.1 The consolidated Asia/Pacific ATM POC List is provided at **Attachment A**. It includes Points of Contact for:
 - Administration (ADM);
 - Aeronautical Information Service (AIS);
 - Airport Collaborative Decision Making (A-CDM);
 - Air Traffic Flow Management (ATFM);
 - Asia/Pacific Region ATS Route Catalogue (ARC);
 - Air Traffic Control (ATC);
 - Contingency Coordination Team (CCT);
 - Airspace Safety and FIT (SAF); and
 - Search and Rescue (SAR).
- 2.2 The List includes POCs from selected non-APAC States, where there is a need for interregional coordination.

- 2.3 The List is presented to all appropriate technical meetings in order to ensure it is kept upto-date. Accordingly, participants are invited to examine the AIS POCs for their Administration, and inform ICAO at the earliest possible opportunity of any changes to the name/s, position title and contact details for the nominated POCs.
- 2.4 The following Asia/Pacific Administrations have not yet nominated any AIS POC:

Afghanistan, Cook Islands, France (French Polynesia), Kiribati, Marshall Islands, Micronesia, Nauru, Palau, Samoa, Solomon Islands, Timor Leste, Tonga, Tuvalu, Vanuatu

2.5 The List will be separately circulated by the Secretariat to all registered participants for update. Changes or new entries to the List may be provided by email to the ICAO Regional Office apac@icao.int, with a courtesy copy to pchalayonnawin@icao.int.
