November 20 - March 31 (131 days)


(Except during the above periods, snow removal is

handled as temporary snow removal.)

Resident runway unit


December 1 to March 15 (5:00 a.m. to 9:30 p.m.)

I'm at the center so I can respond immediately, snow or shine.




By clearing snow from the two runways alternately, snow removal can be carried out without interrupting aircraft operations!

Snow removal in a V-formation on the runway (total length 3,000 m, width 60 m) "Full-width one-way snow removal" is only done at New Chitose Airport in Japan.



Finish 3000 meters in 20 minutes!



About 2,000 lights have to be cleared by hand..
