RASG-APAC/14 MEETING OUTCOMES

(Presented by the Secretariat)

SUMMARY

This paper shares with the AOP/SG/9 the outcomes of RASG-APAC/14 meeting which may be of interest to AOP/SG.

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 The Regional Aviation Safety Group Asia and Pacific Regions (RASG-APAC) was established in October 2011 following the ICAO Council decision in May 2010 and supported by the 47th Conference of the Directors General of Civil Aviation, Asia and Pacific Regions in October 2010.
- 1.2 Consistent with the Planning and Implementation Regional Group (PIRG) mechanism established for addressing air navigation matters and deficiencies, the RASG-APAC has been established with the primary objective of addressing flight safety matters.
- 1.3 The RASG-APAC Term-of-Reference (TOR) calls for the development and implementation of a work programme that supports a regional performance framework for the management of safety.
- 1.4 To assist RASG-APAC in meeting its objectives, Asia Pacific Regional Safety Team (APRAST) supported by various sub-working groups like the APAC AIG, SRP Working Group, SEI Working Group and Asia Pacific Regional Aviation Safety Plan (APRASP) Working Group were established.
- 1.5 RASG-APAC and APRAST have provided the APAC States and industry partners with a forum to share, discuss and address existing and emerging safety concerns, SEIs and Safety Data Analysis in the APAC Region.

2. DISCUSSION

2. 1 Since its inception in 2011, RASG-APAC held 13 meetings. The Fourteenth Meeting of the Regional Aviation Safety Group – Asia and Pacific Regions (RASG-APAC/14) was held at was held at the Bangkok, Thailand from 28-29 November 2024. The Meeting was attended by 94 participants face to face and 15 participants online from 22 States/Administrations and 09 International Organizations/Industry Partners. The Progress Report of the RASG-APAC/14 Meeting's Decisions/Conclusions is provided as **Appendix A** to this paper.

- 2.2 RASG-APAC/14 adopted ten (10) Decisions, out of which Five (05) Decisions are 'In Progress' (RASG-APAC 14/2, 14/3, 14/4, 14/5, 14/10) and Five (05) are 'Proposed to be Closed.
