#### REPORT OF THE TWELFTH PIRG AND RASG REGIONAL COORDINATION MEETING

#### **SUMMARY**

This paper summarizes the outcomes of the 12<sup>th</sup> coordination meeting between APANPIRG & RASG-APAC held on 27 November 2025 in the hybrid format.

Strategic Objectives:

- A: **Safety** Enhance global civil aviation safety
- B: Air Navigation Capacity and Efficiency—Increase the capacity and improve the efficiency of the global aviation system

#### 1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 The Twelfth PIRG & RASG Regional Coordination Meeting was held on 27 November 2024 in ICAO Bangkok Office in the Hybrid format. ## **REPORT**

#### 1. <u>Introduction</u>

- 1.1 The Twelfth PIRG & RASG Regional Coordination Meeting was held on 27 November 2024 in ICAO Bangkok Office in the Hybrid format. The Meeting was co-chaired by Captain Manuel Antonio Lara Tamayo and Captain Norazman Bin Mahmud, Chairpersons of APANPIRG and RASG-APAC respectively. The Meeting was also attended by Ms. Theresa Levestam (online participation) and Mr. HAN Kok Juan, First and Second Vice-Chairpersons of APANPIRG, Ms. Yamani Chan, Senior Operations Officer, CAD Hong Kong, China on behalf of the Vice-Chairperson of RASG-APAC, APANPIRG, RASG-APAC Sub-groups' Chairpersons and Officials of the ICAO Secretariat.

  - Agenda Item 2: Overlapping issues/initiatives that required to be coordinated between the APANPIRG and RASG-APAC Sub-Groups

#### 3. Summary of Discussions

#### Agenda Item 1 — Effective coordination mechanism between APANPIRG & RASG-APAC

- 3.1 The Meeting was informed that APANPIRG and RASG-APAC Midyear Review and Coordination Meeting is usually held in July/August every year.
- 3.2 Both Chairpersons and Vice-Chairpersons shared their views on the importance of establishing a suitable mechanism for enhanced coordination between safety and air navigation domains in view of overlapping issues and initiatives. Acknowledging the current situation and recognizing limited available resources in the Asia/Pacific Region, it was agreed that the existing Sub-groups of APANPIRG and RASG-APAC need to collaborate further in implementing such systems or mechanisms.
- 3.3 The Secretariat informed the Meeting that in the development of APAC Regional Aviation Safety Plan (RASP) under the current RASG-APAC framework, there was a lack of coordination for inputs from ANS and AGA domains.
- 3.4 During discussion, it was also suggested to check with other regional offices about their experience sharing and feedback on the effective coordination mechanism between APANPIRG & RASG-APAC.

## Agenda Item 2 — Overlapping issues/initiatives that required to be coordinated between APANPIRG and RASG APAC Sub-Groups

- 3.5 To lead the discussion, the Secretariat presented the following pre-identified issues for coordination and collaborative work of relevant APANPIRG and RASG APAC Sub-Groups:
  - (1) Data sharing between RASMAG and SEI/SRP WG on High-Risk Category (HRC) Mid-air collisions (MAC)
  - (2) Workshop on safety assessment on ASBU Elements Implementation
  - (3) Workshop on Harmonizing Unmanned Aircraft Operations over the High Seas
  - (4) Workshop on Turbulence Encounters
  - (5) ICAO Asia/Pacific (APAC) Safety Management Seminar (3 5 February 2025)
     Achieving an Effective SSP/SMS
  - (6) Runway Safety Team Survey
  - (7) Wildlife Hazard Control
- 3.6 After a lengthy deliberation and discussion on the above pre-identified issues, the Meeting agreed that respective Chairpersons of APANPIRG and RASG-APAC Sub-groups would coordinate and work collaboratively on the following common safety issues and deliver the activities listed in the table below:

- 3.7 Chairperson of CNS/SG suggested to explore if any industry, such as, Airon could support and contribute to the workshop on GNSS interference issue.
- 3.8 The Meeting also discussed about *ICAO Asia/Pacific (APAC) Safety Management Seminar* to be organized by ICAO and co-hosted by Flight Safety Foundation on 3 5 February 2025 inviting Air Navigation Service Providers and Aerodrome Operators in addition to stakeholders from Flight Safety. It was agreed that the Seminar Programme will be developed by APRAST Secretariat in coordination with ANSP experts. APANPIRG ATM/SG and AOP/SG Chairpersons/Secretariat would be invited.
- 3.9 The Meeting requested respective Sub-group Chairpersons to report the progress of the above activities to the next PIRG & RASG Coordination Meeting to be held in July/August 2025.

## APANPIRG/36 and RASG-APAC/15 Meetings

3.10 The Meeting noted the willingness of Hong Kong, China to host APANPIRG/36 and RASG-APAC/15 Meetings in Hong Kong, China in the first week of December 2025. However, the Meeting agreed to discuss this at RASG-APAC/14 to be held on 28 – 29 November 2024 for final decision.

#### **Closing of the Meeting**

3.11 APANPIRG and RASG-APAC Chairpersons thanked all the Sub-Group Chairpersons for joining the Coordination Meeting and appreciated the need for such coordination between PIRG and RASG Contributory Bodies in future. The Regional Director thanked Chairpersons and Vice-Chairpersons of APANPIRG and RASG-APAC and all Chairpersons of the Contributory Bodies for their invaluable contribution to the work of the APANPIRG and RASG-APAC. He also thanked all participants for their attendance and valuable contribution to the Meeting.
