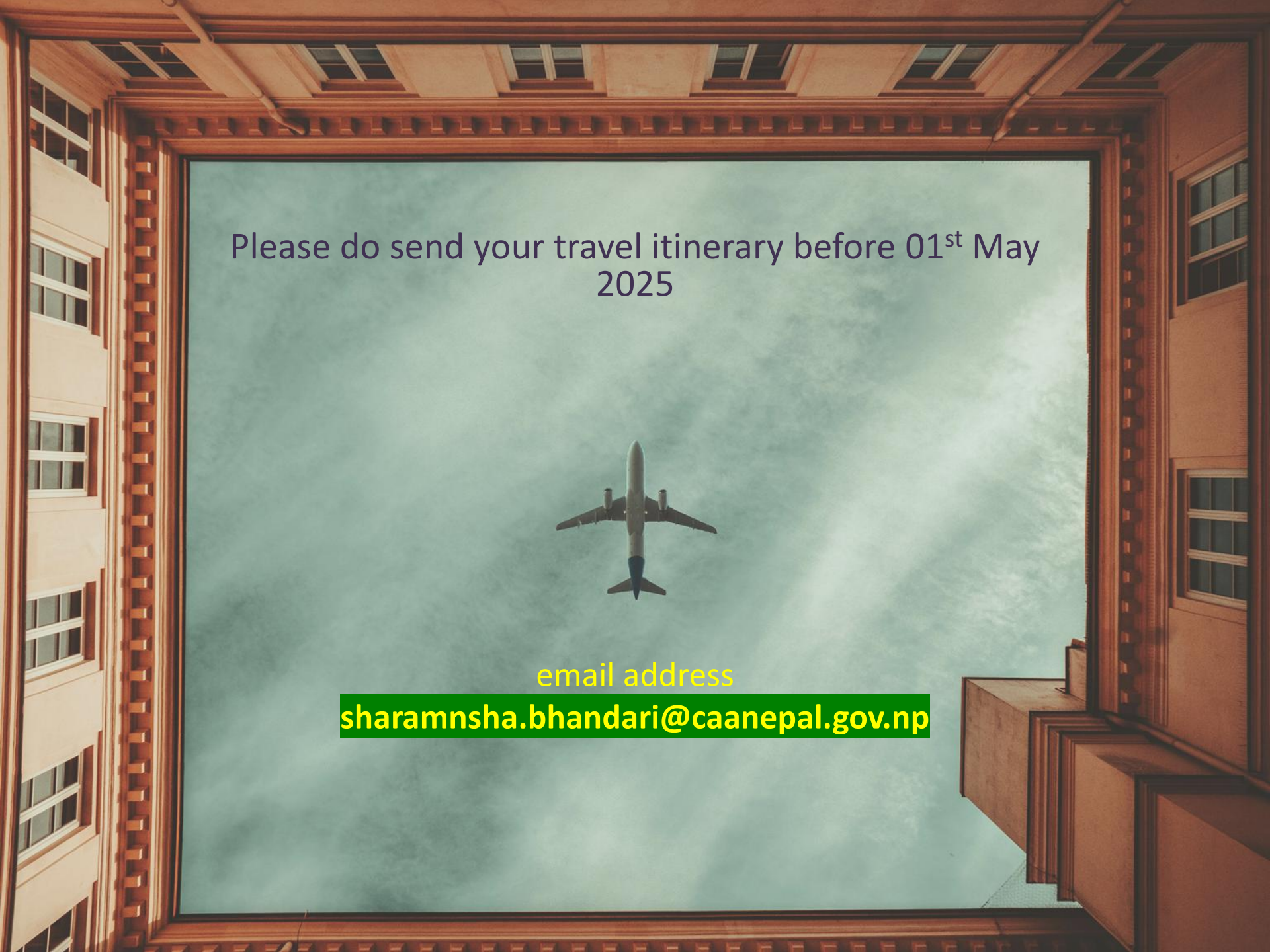


Travel Requirements

- Visa and Arrival

- Visa: Most nationalities can get a visa on arrival or apply online
- Link: <https://nepaliport.immigration.gov.np/>
- Arrival: Complete immigration and customs at the terminal
- Note: Have your passport and travel itinerary ready

Flying to Pokhara from Kathmandu

1. Arrive at Tribhuvan International Airport (KTM)

2. Reach out to Help Desk at International Arrival

3. Immigration & Customs: Present passport, visa and other Related Documents.

4. Baggage Claim: Collect luggage in the arrival hall

5. Reach out to Help Desk at Domestic Departure

6. Domestic Terminal: Head towards domestic check-in counters

7. Book Flight: Major Domestic Carrier Yeti Airlines, Buddha Air and Shree Airlines and proceed towards security clearance

8. Board Flight: 25-minute flight to Pokhara (PRIA)

Layover in Kathmandu: Quick Activities

- Explore Nearby

- Durbar Square: Historic palaces and temples (30 min to 1 hr from the KTM Airport depending upon Traffic Conditions)
- Thamel: Souvenir shopping and Local to Intercontinental cafes (Nearby Durbar Square)
- Swayambhunath (Monkey Temple): Stupa with city views (1 hr to 1.5 hr from KTM Airport depending upon Traffic Conditions)
- Local Eateries: Try mo-mo or Newari snacks near the airport or anywhere around the City.
- Chandragiri Hills: Explore A Sacred Hindu Temple Atop the hill with Mesmerizing Views of Mountain Range and the City.
 - ✓ 1.5 hr to 2 hr Drive From the airport up to the Base Station.
 - ✓ 20 min. Uphill Cable Car ride to the top.

- Top Sights

- Lakes: Boating with Himalayan views mainly in Phewa, Begnas, Rupa; only few of many lakes in Pokhara
- Sarangkot: Sunrise over Annapurna range
- Tal Barahi Temple: Sacred island temple in Phewa Lake
- Annapurna Base Camp Trek: A 5-day Iconic Himalayan trek
- Kushma Bunjee: World's 2nd Highest Bungee Jumping.



Local Delicacies and Dining

- Taste of Pokhara
 - Dal Bhat: Lentil soup with rice and curries
 - Momo: Steamed dumplings (non-veg or veg)
 - Tibetan Bread: Fried bread, often with tea
 - Lakeside Dining: Cafes with international and Nepali cuisine



Cultural Highlights

- Tradition and Modernity
 - Traditional: Gurung and Magar festivals like Dashain
 - Modern: Lakeside nightlife with live music
 - Markets: Handicrafts, thangka paintings, pashminas
 - Dress Code: Modest attire for temples
