

APAC States Participation in ACT-SAF

ICAO <u>Assistance</u>, <u>Capacity-building and <u>Training on Sustainable Aviation Fuel</u> (ACT-SAF):</u>

- This programme was launched in June 2022, prior to the LTAG agreement by 41st Assembly
- ACT-SAF objectives:
 - 1. Create opportunities for States to develop full potential in SAF development / deployment
 - Tailored support for States in various stages of SAF development / deployment
 - 3. Facilitate partnerships and cooperation
 - 4. Foster knowledge sharing and recognition of SAF initiatives around the world
- APAC States Participation in ACT-SAF (20)





