Management of changes

The management of change (ORA.GEN.200)

- The organization should manage safety risks related to a change. The management of change should be a documented process to identify external and internal change that may have an adverse effect on safety.
- It should make use of the organization's existing hazard identification, risk assessment and mitigation processes.

Documented process

Hazard identification list

- Continuous improvement
- The organization should continuously seek to improve its safety performance. Continuous improvement should be achieved through:
 - a) proactive and reactive evaluations of facilities, equipment, documentation and procedures through safety audits and surveys;
 - b) proactive evaluation of individuals' performance to verify the fulfilment of their safety responsibilities; and
 - c) reactive evaluations in order to verify the effectiveness of the system for control and mitigation of risk.

Management of change

- Authority should have a procedure for management of change
- Evaluation of priority and proper assessment
- Man power
- Reliability in how to train inspector
- Continuous monitoring of certification process
- Continuous monitoring of finding and follow up
