Aim	<i>To develop the inspectors' knowledge and understanding of the State's responsibilities for the conduct of Dangerous Goods Oversight; including granting operational approvals and shipment authorizations; safety investigations and enforcement</i>
Syllabus	➤ Introduction, course objectives, pre-course experience, historical background resulting in the current requirements, ➤ Regulatory framework and relationships between ICAO, and IATA, ➤ The Shipper's responsibilities for Classification, Special Provisions, State and operator variations, Packaging (including Package Test Requirements and provisions for Limited Quantities, Excepted Quantities and De Minimis Quantities), ➤ Marking, Labelling and Documentation, ➤ Requirements for shipping lithium batteries and infectious substances, ➤ Training requirements applicable to all entities and approval by the State, ➤ Provisions for dangerous goods carried by passengers and crew, ➤ The Operator's responsibilities for: ✓ <i>establishing dangerous goods policies & procedures in its operations manual,</i> ✓ <i>information to passengers and compliance with baggage restrictions,</i> ✓ <i>operational approval to transport Dangerous Goods as cargo,</i> ✓ <i>the acceptance, handling and stowage of dangerous goods,</i> ✓ <i>segregation/separation, securing, dry ice limits,</i> ✓ <i>Cargo Aircraft only restrictions,</i> ✓ <i>information to the pilot in command,</i> ✓ <i>occurrence reporting & emergency response,</i> ✓ <i>dangerous goods safety risk assessments, and</i> ✓ <i>compliance monitoring</i> ➤ Helicopter operations, ➤ The development and implementation of the States' Dangerous Goods Programme, ➤ State oversight of shippers, freight forwarders, designated postal operators, ground handling agents and air operators ➤ Dangerous goods safety investigations and enforcement, ➤ Shipment exemptions and approvals, ➤ Audit preparation, opening and closing meetings with the auditee, ➤ Raising findings and observations

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Syllabus	➤ Oversight of an air operator: ✓ <i>Approval/acceptance of the operations manual,</i> ✓ <i>Review and approval of dangerous goods training programmes,</i> ✓ <i>Controls over dangerous goods training delivery and records,</i> ✓ <i>Identification and shipment from engineering stores,</i> ✓ <i>Passenger handling,</i> ✓ <i>Acceptance, handling and stowage of dangerous goods and provision of information to the pilot in command, and</i> ✓ <i>Management System (occurrence reporting, safety risk assessments and compliance monitoring)</i> ➤ Oversight of a designated postal operator ➤ Review and approval of the procedures for controlling the introduction of dangerous goods in mail into air transport, dangerous goods training programmes and specific approval for the introduction of lithium batteries contained in equipment. -----XX-----
