1. <u>Dates and Venue</u>

1.1. The ICAO APAC Airport and Airspace Capacity Assessment Workshop will be held at the Hotel Tentrem Yogyakarta, Yogyakarta, Indonesia, from 02 June 2025 (Monday) to 05 June 2025 (Thursday). The workshop will start at 09:00 hours (local time, UTC+7) each day. Details of the workshop venue are as follows:

2. Registration of Participants

- 2.1. Participants are required to pre-register using the online registration form available on the event's ICAO webpage (https://www.icao.int/APAC/Meetings/Pages/2025-Capacity-Assessment-WS.aspx), and to follow the instructions to complete the pre-registration.
- 2.2. Documentation requirement for Registration
 - A formal letter or email of Designation/Nomination from a Member State/Administration is required for registration(s). The letter should be on official letterhead and signed by the appropriate authority or authorized signatory for the government entity of the State/Administration. The letter/email should be addressed to the ICAO APAC Regional Director in response to the State Letter T 3/9.17 AP032/25 (ATM). Please include the full name, title, and email address of each nominee.
 - For international organizations (IOs): Please note that only international organizations which are recognized by ICAO can register to attend in this category. The following link contains a list of recognized IOs: List of International Organizations.
 - Please submit the letter or email of Designation/Nomination to apac@icao.int; with a copy to the Secretariat.
 - Once approved by ICAO, a confirmation email will be provided to the individuals nominated by the State/Administration/IOs.
- 2.3. Participants are required to carry a valid government-issued identity card or passport for verification of their identity.

2.4. Participants are requested to register at the Registration Desk located at the entrance of Tentrem 1 Ballroom, between 08:30 and 09:00 hours on the opening day of the workshop. Participants are required to wear badges throughout the period of the workshop for easy identification.

3. Event Documents for Distribution etc.

4. Useful Travel Information

4.1. Passport

All foreign nationals entering Indonesia must possess a passport or other valid documents for travel valid for a minimum of six (6) months from the date of entry into Indonesia.

4.2. **Visa**

It is mandatory for participants requiring entry visa to Indonesia to apply/obtain official visa from the Indonesia's Embassy or Consulate in their Country prior to their departure to Indonesia or online on https://evisa.imigrasi.go.id/.

4.3. Customs

Each traveler is permitted to bring items allowed as per the customs requirement in the following link: https://ecd.beacukai.go.id/.

5. Other Information

5.1. Currency, Credit Cards and Banking Services

The unit of currency in Indonesia is Rupiah.

Foreign currency exchanges and ATMs are readily accessible at the airport and major shopping destinations.

International Credit Cards, such as Visa, Master Card, etc. are usually accepted at most hotels, department stores and restaurants.

Commercial banks, currency exchanges and major foreign currencies and branch networks stay open from 08:00 to 16:00 hours for customers, five days a week, from Monday to Friday, with Saturday and Sunday being the days of closure, with a few exceptions. On Friday, the aforementioned financial institutions may be closed from 11:00 to 13:00 hours to observe the Friday prayer.

5.2. **Drinking Water**

It is recommended that all visitors drink only bottled water/beverages.

5.3. **Electricity**

Voltage in Indonesia is 230VAC 50Hz, and the 2-pin power plugs and sockets (outlets) of type C and type F are commonly used.

5.4. **Insurance**

Participants are advised to have insurance coverage for any unexpected contingency including transport hazards (taxi, buses, rented cars etc.) and medical coverage.

5.5. Time Zone

Time in Indonesia is 7 hours ahead of the Coordinated Universal Time (i.e. UTC+7).

5.6. Weather Conditions

The average temperatures for the month of June are between 24°C and 33°C. Please refer https://www.accuweather.com/en/id/yogyakarta/211671/june-weather/211671?year=2025 for further updates.

6. <u>Hotel Reservations</u>

6.1. Participants should arrange hotel accommodation in advance. The list of recommended hotels is attached in Annex 1.

7. Transportation

- 7.1. Participants are requested to make their own arrangements for transportation from/to the airport and from/to the events venue. Yogyakarta International Airport is located 90 to 120 minutes from Yogyakarta City by car.
- 7.2. Taxis are available from the Yogyakarta International Airport to all destinations.
- 7.3. An inter-city train operates between the Yogyakarta Airport Train Station and Yogyakarta Train Station in both directions. For train schedules, please visit https://www.railink.co.id/schedule.
- 7.4. Car rental agencies are located at the arrival hall of the Yogyakarta International Airport, Yogyakarta Airport Train Station and Yogyakarta Train Station terminal buildings.
- 7.5. Participants are required to arrange the daily commute to/from the venue. Online transportation services are always available at affordable prices. Please download and install the Gojek or Grab app from the Apple Store or Google Play Store before using these services.
