SUMMARY

This Paper provides a list of Conference of Directors General of Civil Aviation, Asia and Pacific Regions conducted from 1960 to 2025. The paper also presents the future DGCA Conference hosting offers made by States/Administrations so far.

SCHEDULE OF CONFERENCES OF DGCA_s IN THE FORESEEABLE FUTURE

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 As a result of offers by several States/Administrations to host the annual Conference of the Directors General of Civil Aviation, Asia and Pacific Regions, a schedule of potential Host States/Administrations is prepared annually and updated as necessary.

2. DISCUSSION

2.1 The development of a schedule of Conferences to be convened in the foreseeable future has facilitated host States/Administrations to make the necessary arrangements in a timely manner. In order to allow prospective host States/Administrations as long a lead time as possible to plan and prepare for the event, the schedule will continue to be updated annually.

2.2 As part of continuing commitment and support to the International Civil Aviation Organization, Malaysia, through the Civil Aviation Authority of Malaysia, formally confirmed by correspondence dated 6 June 2025 its offer to host the 61st Conference of Directors General of Civil Aviation in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia in 2026.

2.3 Appended to this Paper are a complete list of Conferences held to-date as well as a list of States which have not had the opportunity to host the Conference of Directors General of Civil Aviation, Asia/Pacific Region (Attachment A); and list of date, venue and theme Topics of DGCA_s Conference (Attachment B) so far.

2.4 There is no firm hosting offer received by the APAC Regional Office beyond the 2026 DGCA Conference.

3. ACTION BY THE CONFERENCE

3.1 In view of the above, it is proposed that the Conference note with thanks, confirmation of the generous offer to host the next Conferences in 2026 by Malaysia.

3.2 States/Administrations desirous of hosting subsequent Conferences are requested to communicate their offers to the ICAO Regional Office, Bangkok.
