



- All 6 FF-ICE/R1 services
 - > Mandatory services
 - > Optional services
 - > Mixed-mode environment

 - + Implementation consideration
 - + FPL2012/eFPL translation
 - + eASP and eAU responsibilities
 - > Re-evaluation process introduction

Proposed Major Contents



APAC Regional Implementation Plan (con't)

- 6 FF-ICE/R1 services
 - > Technical considerations, e.g.
 - + Information exchange model standards
 - + Messaging infrastructure
 - > Operational considerations
 - > Messages
 - + Mandatory fields for the region
 - + Feedback response
 - + Versioning
 - + 'Lock-out' period etc.

- + Data storage and retrieval
- + Performance
