Process of Cancelling Flight

- **FPL2012 (Below processes used by some ANSPs)**
 - CNL message received via AMHS
 - System checks
 - Syntax and semantic checks
 - Matching filed flight plan
 - Flight planning staff will reach out to airlines when there are errors/mismatches in flight plan, to determine whether CNL message is sent erroneously
 - **No cancellation allowed once flight has departed**
- **FF-ICE**
 - Flight Cancellation (FC) message sent by eAU via SWIM
 - eASP responds with Submission Response (ACK or REJ) after SR checks (See table below)
 - No Filing Status provided for cancellations

	SR Checks for Flight Cancellation Msg	Remarks
1	Logic/syntax	Wrong/incomplete data format in field
2	FIXM schema compliance	Checks whether field is complaint to FIXM 4.3
3	Mandatory fields	Whether mandatory fields in FIXM 4.3 are filled
4	Flight Association (Check if same flight exists, includes GUF1 check, IG appendix F)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Same flight with different GUF1 found• Different flight with same GUF1 found
5	Rights To Cancel	Checks if the originator has the right to cancel the flight
6	Flight Plan State	Check if flight has departed
