PROPOSED **PLAN**

- **GOAL**

- FAA is hoping to offer six (6) more GSI training sessions, with the goal of having six (6) new trainers over a two-year period.


- **Next Step**

- FAA offer a full round (AIR, OPS, PEL) of GSI to the region in each of at least two locations – This has been done with one round each in Dhaka, Bangladesh and Bangkok, Thailand. FAA also offered one additional session of GSI-AIR in Nadi, Fiji. Over 80 inspectors trained in total.



Update on potential Candidates as ICAO qualified instructors

- 4 States responded to ICAO email regarding request on Update on Candidates for APAC Train The trainer program (TTP) – Fiji, Pakistan, Thailand, and Vanuatu
 - Detail responses on Instructor candidates:
 - 5 Candidates for ICAO GSI-AIR (3 is new listed, 2 are from the existing list)
 - 5 Candidates for ICAO GSI-PEL (All 5 are new listed, 1 of 5 is ICAO Approved Instructor)
 - 4 Candidates for ICAO GSI-OPS (4 are new listed)
 - TTP Management sheet updated accordingly
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Update on potential Candidates as ICAO qualified instructors (Cont'd)

- Total 102 Inspectors are listed on TTP Management Sheet (12 New Inspector Instructor Candidates)
 - 1 Instructor Approved by ICAO IGAT (GSI-PEL)
 - 1 Instructor Application for GSI-AIR Approved by ICAO IGAT (Proposed for OJTI)
 - 7 Inspectors completed TIC (4-AIR, 3-PEL)
