# 2025 Survey on Training Needs of Asia Pacific Region V0.5 &

- 1. The ICAO Asia Pacific Regional Training Cooperation Framework (RTCF) endorsed at the 58th Conference of Directors-General of Civil Aviation, Asia and Pacific Regions (DGCA/58) in October 2023 proposed by Regional Cooperation Mechanisms Task Force (RCM TF) to focus exclusively on strengthening and evolving existing regional mechanisms for regional cooperation on capability and capacity building.
- 2. To enhance regional training cooperation, the first RTCF/WG meeting agreed to pursue regulatory training need analysis (TNA) that would determine the common and/or evolving needs of the Asia Pacific region and update the regulatory training needs trend. The outcome of the survey is expected to provide valuable insights to stakeholders to identify the areas of concern for effective design and deployment of training support to the required bodies for the enhancement of aviation safety in the region that will support ICAO strategic objectives and goals as well as commitment to the Beijing Declaration 2018 and Delhi Declaration 2024.
