

- primarily Annex 17
- also includes the security-related
   Standards of Annex 9






### A State's AVSEC Oversight System

- The critical elements of a State's aviation security oversight system


# Critical Elements


- The critical elements (CEs) are essentially the tools of a State's aviation security oversight system and are required for the effective implementation of security-related policies and associated procedures.
- The CEs of an aviation security oversight system encompass the whole spectrum of civil aviation security activities.

System








#### CE-1: Primary Aviation Security Legislation

- □ Policies and requirements relating to Annex 17 Standards and to Annex 9 Security-related Standards







- Terms and conditions for certification
- Measures for response to acts of unlawful interference
- Dissemination of security-critical information



#### **CE 8: Resolution of Security Concerns**

- Resolution, analysis and reporting of identified deficiencies
- Implementation of measures related to:
  - access control
  - aircraft
  - passengers and their cabin baggage
  - hold baggage
  - cargo, mail and other goods
  - special categories of passengers
  - landside
  - cyber threat
