4. Transfer Services

4.1 Participants are required to make their own transportation arrangement upon arrival in and departure from Langkawi. Most of the hotels run their transfer service to and from the airport with additional charges. Public transportation is easily accessible at the hotels. Grab is the mostly used Apps for taxi services in Malaysia.

5. <u>Visa. Insurance and Customs</u>

- 5.1 Participants must possess the documentation required to enter and stay in Malaysia. Participants may wish to obtain information on Malaysia entry requirements by accessing the Immigration Department of Malaysia website
- Application for visa is the responsibility of the State or delegate concerned and should be requested well in advance as for certain countries visa processing may require additional security screening time. In case a visa support letter is required, the appropriate authority, administration or State in question should send a request, on official letterhead, to the ICAO APAC Office, at least 6 weeks before the start of the meeting. No personal invitations can be issued by ICAO.
- Participants must be medically fit and in possession of insurance coverage to meet expenses for any unexpected event, including illness or medical emergency during the meeting. ICAO will not take responsibility for any expenses incurred concerning participation to its meetings/events.
- 5.4 Please refer to the Royal Malaysian Customs Department Website for the restrictions on the import of foreign currency.

6. Travel to Langkawi

6.1 Langkawi International Airport is an airport in Padang Matsirat, Langkawi, Kedah, Malaysia. The airport is about 20 km from the city center and 11 km to the meeting venue.

7. <u>Further Information</u>

- 7.1 Information about weather condition may be found on the website of Malaysia Meteorological Department at https://www.met.gov.my/. Tropical or light weight and washable cottons will suffice and woollens are not necessary.
- 7.2 Dress code for the meeting is formal. Casual clothing is not suitable for the meeting.
- 7.3 Malaysian time is eight (8) hours ahead of Co-ordinated Universal Time (UTC+8).
- 7.4 International credit cards such as American Express, Visa, Master Card, etc. are normally accepted at major hotels and department stores.
- Most of the commercial banks exchange major foreign currencies and are open from 0930 to 1600 hours from Monday through Friday and some keep the foreign exchange counter open until 2100 hours. Foreign exchange counters operated by various commercial banks are located at several places in the city and are also open during Saturdays and Sundays and on public holidays from 1000 to 2000 hours. To change travellers' cheques, you are required to show your passport.
