Before Entering Malaysia

- Digital Arrival Card registration required for foreign passengers.
- Registration is possible 3 days prior to arrival. Please register through the MDAC web site.

STEP 1 : BEFORE ARRIVING MALAYSIA

Langkawi International Airport

Arrival at Langkawi International Airport

- Upon arriving at Langkawi, passengers will disembark from the aircraft and proceed to the terminal.

Immigration & Passport Control

- International passengers arriving directly to Langkawi are required to go through Immigration and Passport Control. Please fill in the MDEC border pass before arriving.

Transiting

- Transiting passengers from Kuala Lumpur are not required to go through the immigration process.

Baggage Claim

- After immigration, follow the signs to the baggage claim area to collect your luggage.

Arrival Hall & Exiting the Airport

- After clearing customs, you will enter the arrival hall, where you can find facilities like ATMs, currency exchange and a taxi counter. There are also information desks if you need assistance.

Transportation Options

- E-Hailing, Taxis, Car Rentals and shuttle services are available to take passengers to various parts of Langkawi. Many visitors also pre-arrange transfers through hotels.

Kilim Geoforest Park: Explore this UNESCO Global Geopark via boat tours through mangroves, caves and limestone cliffs.

Tanjung Rhu Beach: Soft white sand and peaceful surroundings which is ideal for relaxation.

Underwater World Langkawi: Family-friendly aquarium showcasing marine life, including penguins and rays.

Langkawi Wildlife Park: An interactive zoo experience for nature and animal lovers.

Eagle Square (Dataran Lang): A landmark featuring a giant eagle statue which symbolize Langkawi.
