REQUESTING STATES/ADMINISTRATIONS TO SHARE UPDATES ON AERODROME-RELATED INFORMATION

(Presented by the SECRETARIAT)

SUMMARY

This paper proposes States/Administrations in the Asia and Pacific (APAC) Region to share updates on aerodrome-related information which aims to support regional planning, monitoring of the implementation progress of the aerodrome design and operation provisions, and reporting activities, including updates to the Asia/Pacific Air Navigation Plan (ANP). States/Administrations are requested to submit updates to the ICAO APAC Office by the end of February of each year.

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 In order to effectively support the implementation of ICAO Standards and Recommended Practices (SARPs), regional planning, and monitoring activities, the ICAO APAC Office requires up-to-date and reliable aerodrome-related information from States/Administrations.

1.2 The need for regular and reliable aerodrome-related information, particularly in relation to aerodrome certification, publication status, and the implementation of key safety initiatives, has been consistently highlighted within the Aerodrome Operations and Planning Sub-group (AOP/SG) and its contributing bodies, i.e., the Asia/Pacific Aerodrome Design and Operations Task Force (AP-ADO/TF) and the Asia/Pacific Aerodrome Assistance Working Group (AP-AA/WG), and the Asia/Pacific Wildlife Hazard Management Working Group (AP-WHM WG).

2. DISCUSSION

2.1 To support regional planning, monitoring the implementation progress of the aerodrome design and operation provisions, and reporting activities, including updates to the Asia/Pacific Air Navigation Plan (ANP), the Secretariat proposes States/Administrations in the Asia and Pacific (APAC) Region to share updates on aerodrome-related information.

- 2.2 States/Administrations are requested to share updates on the following information:
- a) International Aerodromes to be Published in the ANP: an updated list of international aerodromes to be published in the ANP through Proposal for the Amendment of APAC ANP Volume I & II (<https://www.icao.int/APAC/apac-air-navigation-plan-anp>);
 - b) Certification of Aerodromes: an updated list of certified aerodromes, including those under temporary or conditional certification and indicated timelines for conversion to permanent certification;
 - c) Publication of the Status of Certification of Aerodromes in AIP: an updated list of status of certification of aerodromes that are yet to be published in the AIP AD 1.5;
 - d) Implementation of the Global Reporting Format (GRF): an updated information on the publication of procedures for assessment and reporting of runway condition in the AIP AD 1.2.2, including an updated list of aerodromes which have been implementing GRF;
 - e) Implementation of Aircraft Classification Rating-Pavement Classification Rating (ACR-PCR): an updated list of aerodromes which have implemented ACR-PCR pavement strength reporting methodology;
 - f) Implementation of Airport Master Plan: an updated list of aerodromes for which Airport Master Plan has been developed or under development;
 - g) Implementation of Wildlife Hazard Management Programme (WHMP): an updated State Action Plan for Establishment and Implementation of Wildlife Hazard Management Programme, which could be accessed at: <https://www.icao.int/sites/default/files/APAC/Documents/State-Action-Plan-for-Development-and-Implementation-of-WHMP-Generic-Template-Jan-2023.docx>; and
 - h) Runway Safety Team (RST): an updated list of international aerodromes which have established a runway safety team. The Framework for Monitoring the Establishment and Implementation of Runway Safety Team (RST) at Aerodromes in APAC States could be accessed at: <https://www.icao.int/sites/default/files/APAC/Documents/edocs/AGA/Runway%20Safety/ICAO-Runway-Safety-Team-Questionnaire-R1.xlsx>.

2.3 For regional monitoring and reporting purposes, States/Administrations are requested to submit updates to the ICAO APAC Office **by the end of February** of each year.
