What: That, in order to support a coherent and effective transition of Seamless ANS planning into APAC ANP Volume III: 1. the ICAO APAC Secretariat establish a small working group to review and update the Asia/Pacific Seamless ANS Plan prior to the planned migration into Volume III; 2. the working group should take into consideration: a) preservation of key planning and developmental constructs; b) relevance of ASBU priorities, timelines and dependencies; c) how implemented or mature elements should be reflected; and d) alignment with relevant APANPIRG and its contributory bodies outcomes; and 3. the Secretariat report recommendations of the working group to the appropriate APANPIRG bodies. Project Objective	To review the APAC Air Navigation Plan (ANP) Volume III considering the Asia/Pacific Seamless ANS Plan and develop recommendations for future amendments, taking into consideration inputs from APANPIRG contributory bodies, regional implementation experience, and developments in ICAO global planning frameworks, including the Global Air Navigation Plan (GANP), Aviation System Block Upgrade (ASBU) framework and Minimum Implementation Path (MIP).
Project Outcomes	1. Conduct a comprehensive review of the APAC ANP Volume III considering the Asia/Pacific Seamless ANS Plan. 2. Develop recommendations for future amendments to APAC ANP Volume III to ensure that regional priorities, implementation pathways, dependencies and performance expectations remain relevant and coherent. 3. Review the alignment between APAC regional priorities and ICAO global planning initiatives, including GANP, MIP, and develop coordinated regional recommendations where appropriate.

Project Terms of Reference / High-Level Tasks	1. Review the APAC ANP Volume III and identify areas requiring refinement, clarification or enhancement. 2. Review recommendations, conclusions and outcomes from APANPIRG contributory bodies and assess their implications for APAC ANP Volume III. 3. Assess the continued relevance of APAC regional priorities, implementation targets, timelines and performance expectations reflected in APAC ANP Volume III. 4. Review whether capability dependencies, enabling capabilities and implementation pathways are adequately reflected within APAC ANP Volume III and recommend enhancements where necessary. 5. Review the alignment between APAC ANP Volume III and relevant ICAO planning frameworks, including the GANP 8th Edition and ASBU framework, and the first version of MIP to be proposed for the endorsement by the 44th Ordinary Session of the ICAO Assembly (A/44) in 2028.

	6. Assess whether APAC regional implementation priorities and operational needs are adequately reflected in the MIP and identify any gaps, omissions, dependency considerations or interoperability issues that may warrant regional input to ICAO. 7. Consider how mature, implemented and baseline capabilities should be reflected within APAC ANP Volume III to maintain focus on active regional implementation priorities. 8. Develop recommendations for future amendments to APAC ANP Volume III, including updates to priorities, implementation targets, performance indicators, implementation pathways and capability relationships. 9. Develop coordinated APAC recommendations on matters related to the ICAO MIP and other relevant global planning initiatives, as appropriate. 10. submit recommendations to ATM Sub-Group and APANPIRG for consideration 11. Prepare draft amendments and supporting rationale for consideration by the relevant APANPIRG contributory bodies and APANPIRG.
