CRV OG OPERATIONS MANUAL UPDATES

SUMMARY

This paper presents the status of the current Draft of the CRV Operations Manual.

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 Since the publication of the CRV OG Operations Manual in April 2022, there have been many updates, mostly coming from the discussions of the various Ad Hoc Groups.

1.2 The current version of the CRV OG Operations Manual was published after adoption by the CRV OG13 Meeting as version 1.4 by **Decision CRV OG/13/02**.

1.3 This paper shares the plan for further updating the CRV OG Operations Manual for Meeting consideration.

2. DISCUSSION

2.1 From the CRV OG/13 Meeting held from 5-8 March 2025 in Wellington, New Zealand, to date, much progress has been achieved by the CRV OG Ad-hoc Expert Groups. These progresses have been in the form of various new documents, clauses and revised terms and conditions. All of these works are being consolidated by the CRV OG Ad-hoc Expert group.

2.2 As much of this content needs approval of the CRV OG/15 Meeting, and there is a significant amount of content required to be updated into the current version of the manual after their adoption by the CRV OG/15 Meeting, if adopted, it is proposed to retain the current version of the manual.

2.3 The content to be updated into the manual includes, but is not limited to, Bandwidth calculations, SOP for joining Space-Based ADS B Implementation, Procedures and Test procedure for using residual CRV Bandwidth, will be provided as separate documents in the Operations Manual Current Version folder.

2.4 The CRV OG Operations Manual will be updated to incorporate all agreed changes after the CRV OG/15 Meeting and will be presented to CRV OG/16 for adoption.
