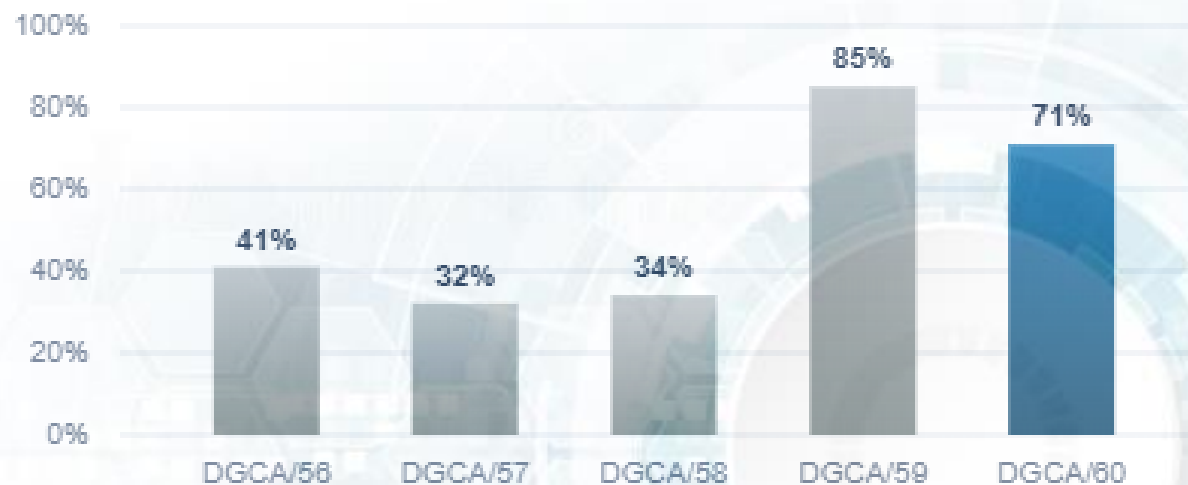


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Status of 60th DGCA Action Items

- Highlights Action Items from the 60th DGCA Conference were circulated and monitored through the DGCA Action Item Tracker Portal.
- States and Administrations have continued reporting implementation progress.
- Several activities are completed or ongoing under the leadership of States, ICAO, and regional organizations.
- Conference decisions continue to support regional cooperation and implementation of ICAO strategic objectives.

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Regional Implementation Progress

- 31% active implementation rate, comprising 10% Completed and 21% In Progress.
- 50% of assignments remain To Commence, while 19% are categorized as Noted/Not Applicable.
- Overall trends indicate a gradual transition from planning to implementation across the region.
- Safety and Security outcome areas demonstrate the strongest implementation momentum.



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Key Implementation Insights

✓ Strong Progress Areas

• **Aviation Safety & Safety Oversight:**

- Leading implementation performance (15% Completed; 38% Active), supported by RASG-APAC initiatives, safety data sharing, and SSP implementation. Aviation Security & Facilitation:
- Strong progress (12% Completed; 31% Active) aligned with GAsEP priorities, including border control, facilitation, and cybersecurity initiatives.
- Capacity Development & Workforce: Positive momentum (10% Completed; 25% Active) through ongoing capacity-building and workforce development activities.

⚠ Areas Requiring Additional Attention

- **Aviation and Environment** : Progress remains comparatively limited, highlighting the need for enhanced support, partnerships, and targeted implementation initiatives.
- **Capacity Development & Workforce:** Despite positive progress, 48% of assignments remain to commence, reflecting workforce retention challenges and resource constraints within technical inspectorates.

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Key Challenges Identified

- Fragmentation
 - Action Items are replaced annually.
 - Difficult to maintain visibility across multiple Conference cycles.
- Volume of Actions
 - Large numbers of Action Items dilute focus on strategic priorities.
 - Resources are spread across many activities.
- Outcome Visibility
 - Tracking emphasizes activities completed.
 - Less visibility on regional impact and collective outcomes.
- Accountability
 - Some actions lack clearly defined ownership, expected outputs, or measurable indicators

The 7 Standing Regional Outcome Areas

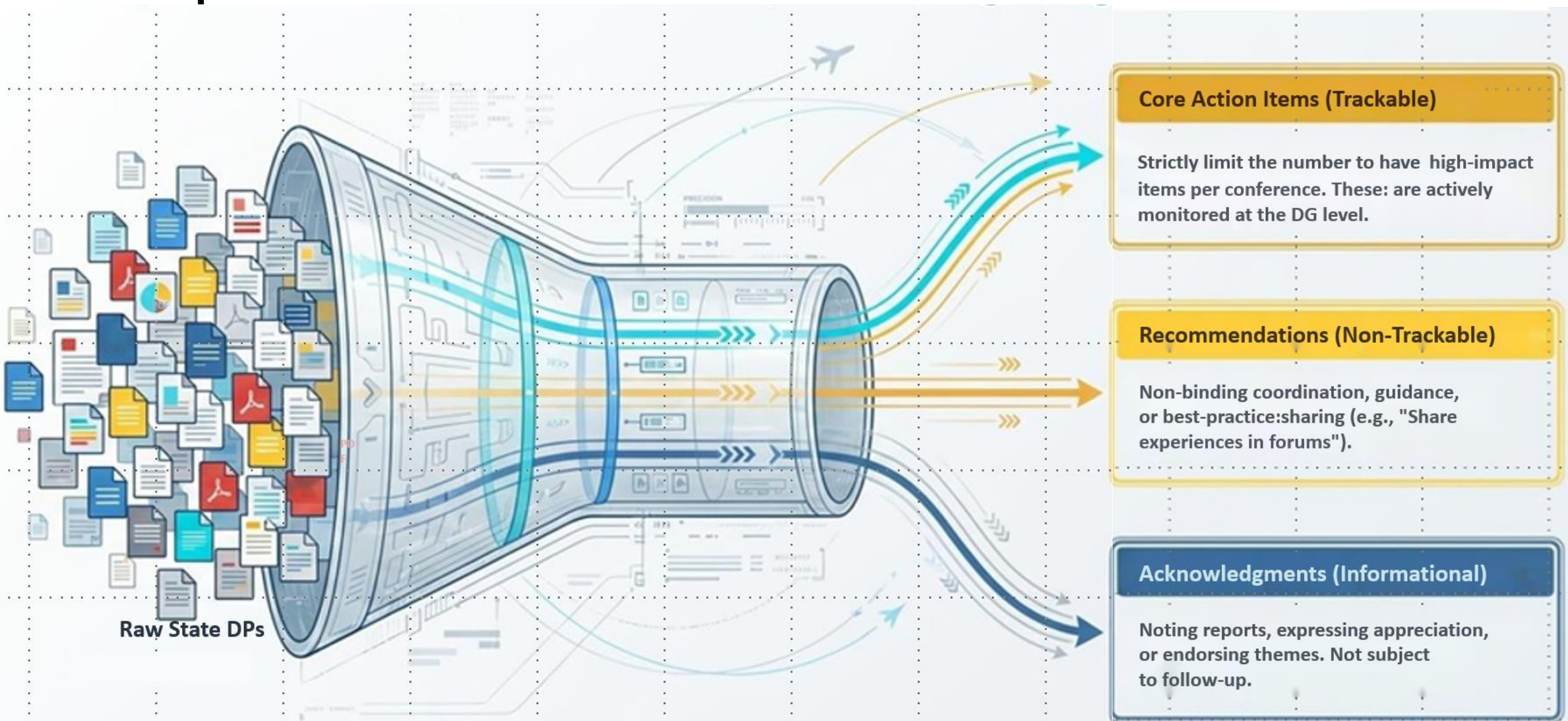
A stable framework aligned with ICAO goals to organize future DPs and Actions.
